



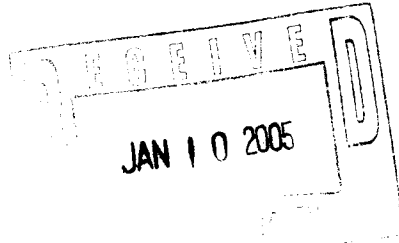

Dear Mr. Fields:

The Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) is in receipt of the Wayland Water Department's perchlorate monitoring reports for the period of September 1 to September 30, 2004 for its eight municipal wells. DEP is accepting these reports even though it has determined that these samples were taken and reported after the required monitoring period. Failure to collect and report within the required monitoring period is a violation. DEP will not take further action for this violation because you have already collected samples to replace the missing samples. However, please note that a record is being kept by DEP for this and all other violations, and it will be reported to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) as required and will appear on the EPA *Envirofacts* web page.

Please be reminded that the DEP Drinking Water Regulations (310 CMR 22.00) and the Guidelines and Policies for public water systems are designed to protect public water supplies, to enhance the quality of drinking water, and to ensure public health protection. You are hereby notified to comply with 310 CMR 22.06D and, effective immediately, stay in compliance with the regulations in the future.
