

Title: Exploring the Official Python.org – Orientation Map

Description: In this scenario, Students will open the python.org website and explore the top menu (**About, Downloads, Documentation, Community, Success Stories, News, Events**). They will note what each section is used for.

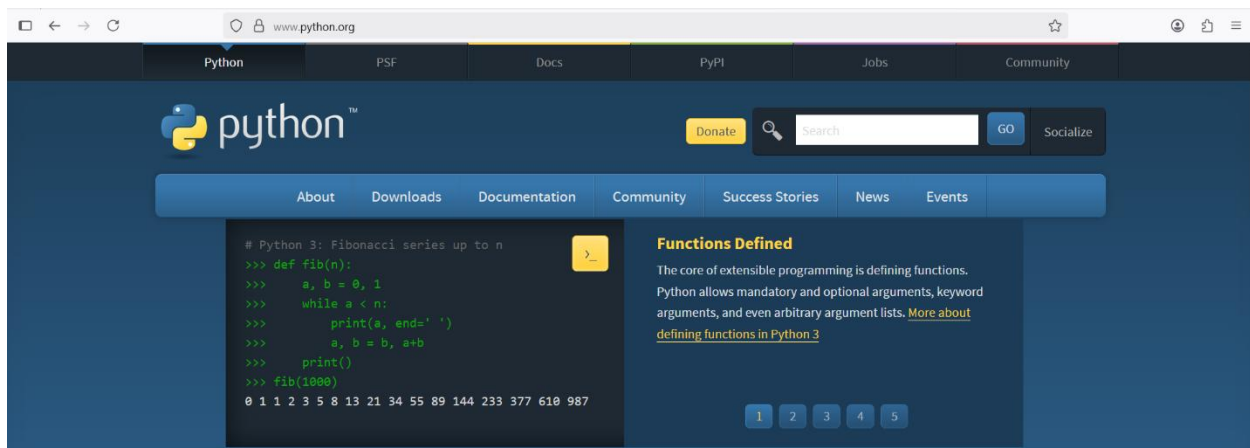
Purpose: The purpose of this activity is to To help students know the official Python website and understand what each main section is for.

Requirements: Computer with Internet, web browser, notebook and pen.

Steps:

1. Open a web browser and go to www.python.org

- It should open official website of python as shown in below image



2. Look at the top menu options such as:

- [About](#), [Downloads](#), [Documentation](#), [Community](#), [Success Stories](#), [News](#), [Events](#)

3. Click on '**About**'

- Write one simple line in your notebook on what this page tells you

4. Click on **‘Downloads’**

- Do not download anything.
- Write one simple line in your notebook on what you find here.

5. Click on **‘Documentation’**

- Note down three items you see like Docs, Beginner’s Guide, PEP Index.
- Write one simple line for each in your notebook.

6. Click on **‘Community’**

- Write one line each in your notebook about two items you see like Conferences or Code Of Conduct.

7. Click on **‘Success Stories’**

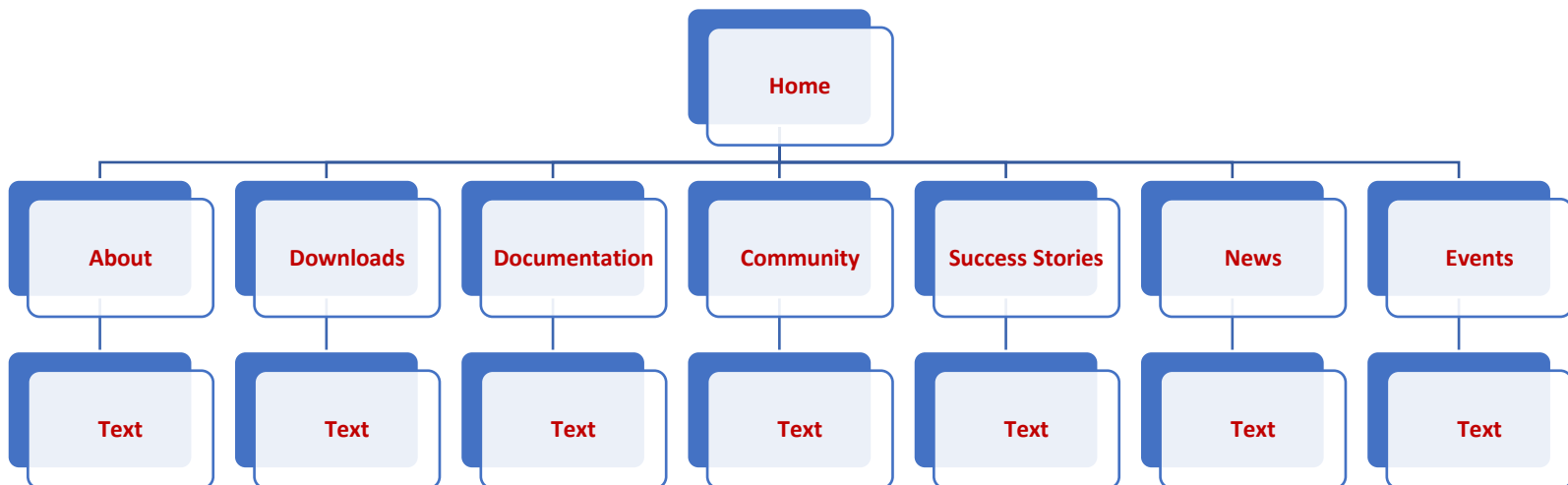
- Write one line in your notebook on what kind of pages are here.

8. Click on 'News' and 'Events'

- Write one line in your notebook on what you see there.

9. Draw a simple map

- Draw a simple map in your notebook with Home in the center and boxes for each menu item with your one-line note under it.



Expected Output:

Students create a one-page 'Python.org Orientation Map' with 7 boxes and a short line for each section.
