- Clean content at site or at warehouse (according to Stutter's cleaning protocols)
- Clean internal and external structures as required.
- Move, pack, inventory homeowner's furniture and contents.
- Assist in the final clean and resetting of contents in homes and business.
- Follow instructions provided from the site supervisor.
- Adhere to all health and safety policies and procedures.
- Comply with federal and provincial laws regulating waste disposal methods.
- Deliver, load, and unload materials. Move materials at worksites.
- Prepare worksite by laying floor protection and sealing off work areas.
- Remove flooring, drywall and other building materials.
