## *Custom San Antonio & Dallas Itinerary*

### **DAY 1: Thursday, April 16, 2026**

6:45pm: Motorcoaches arrive at **JM Tate High School** for loading  
7:30pm: Depart for **San Antonio**  
 Travel through the night – Driver will make periodic rest stops

### **DAY 2: Friday, April 17, 2026**

6:30-7:45am: Breakfast (own expense) en route  
10:00am: Arrive in San Antonio – Meet your GTP Tour Manager  
10:30am-8:00pm: Spend the day at **SIX FLAGS FIESTA TEXAS**, a 200-acre park featuring awesome rides, great shows, and incredible attractions.  
 Lunch (own expense) at the Park  
 Dinner (meal voucher included) at the Park  
8:15pm: Depart for the Hotel  
8:45pm: Approximate check-in to the **HOTEL - TBD**

### **DAY 3: Saturday, April 18, 2026**

6:45-7:45am: Expanded Continental Breakfast (included) at the Hotel  
8:00am: Depart Hotel  
8:30am: Arrive at the Caverns  
9:00-10:30am: Explore the **NATURAL BRIDGE CAVERNS** – the largest known commercial caverns in the state of Texas. It features several unique speleothems and other geological formations.  
11:15am-2:00pm: Lunch (own expense), shop and explore the **RIVER WALK**, a network of walkways along the banks of the San Antonio River, one story beneath the streets of Downtown. Lined by shops and restaurants, the River Walk is an important part of the city's urban fabric and a tourist attraction in its own right. Take a **RIVER BOAT CRUISE** to see the interesting points on the Riverwalk  
2:30-3:30pm: Ride to the top of the 750 ft. **TOWER OF THE AMERICAS** and get a panoramic view of the 6 flags that flew over Texas along with history surrounding that time period.  
3:40pm: Depart for the Hotel  
4:00-5:20pm: Return to the Hotel and freshen-up for the evening activity  
5:30pm: Depart for dinner  
6:00-7:30pm: Dinner (included) at **ALDACO'S Mexican Cuisine**  
8:30-10:00pm: Experience a San Antonio **GHOST TOUR!** Walk back in time and visit exact locations of some of the most horrific acts of violence from San Antonio's cruel and wicked past.
