St. Benedict's Guest House


The winter weather has brought guests to St. Benedict's. Patients with early morning appointments or questionable driving conditions have been able to stay in the comfortable home that you created.

Perception....Reality

Have you ever been absolutely sure of something...until someone gives you positive proof that you were wrong? And even then did you shake your head and say something like "I could swear that...."

That happened to me last week; I was certain about a piece of information that I was sharing and then someone said "I don't think that is right". A friendly but spirited discussion followed that went something like this: "yes it is", "no it isn't" until my coworker found the correct information. I was wrong. Dang, you gotta hate it when that happens.

Did I deliberately tell a piece of misinformation? Was I testing my co workers to see if they knew what the real scoop was? Nope, I just remembered it differently. And it was so real to me that I would have placed money on my facts being correct.

My perception was my reality.

Fortunately for me, when the right information was presented I could take it in and recognize my error. The misinformation was gone, replaced with the correct facts.

Unfortunately for patients with memory loss their perception cannot be changed. We know that what they are saying is not accurate but no matter how many times we try to correct or feed them new information it just doesn't stick. They aren't being stubborn it is simply a case that their perception is their reality. Period.

Millions of hours have been spent trying to "re-orientate" patients that appear confused. We have tried verbal cues, written cues, coaxing, positive reinforcement and even punishment to try and bring them into our reality.

The result is often frustration, maybe anger and at times outright combativeness or withdrawal. Trust is broken as the patient views us as someone who doesn't believe them. Self-esteem and confidence takes a nosedive as patients feel they can do nothing right. Hearts are broken and denial is paramount as families are faced with the reality of the situation.

Our new, improved thought process is to simply join the patient in their reality. Instead of trying to force the issue we redirect or pick some piece of their perception to focus on. If they are insisting they are going to have lunch with a long deceased relative we can talk about how wonderful it would be to see that person and what should we have to eat.

Hopefully the result will be a pleasant trip down memory lane during which both the patient and family or caregiver can smile and relax. This doesn't happen easily as it is in our nature to try and coax our loved ones back to us.

Memory loss is indeed a roller coaster of emotions for all involved, but perhaps we can regain some semblance of control by changing our perception – to meet their reality.

Thrift Store update...

Have you ever wondered who is responsible for stocking and pricing all the Christmas "stuff" at the thrift store? Well it starts with our inmate crew who accepts and sorts the incoming donations throughout the year. Then Bill schleps them to the storeage unit – meticulously arranging and stacking boxes so they can come back to the store in a timely manner – and in the right order – roughly 2000 boxes plus trees total. In October the boxes start returning to the store and they are priced and stocked by thrift store staff and a group of volunteers (who work mostly evenings and weekends) Everything in the store gets shifted to make room for the decorations and a prayer goes up that it will all sell by the new year. In January it starts all over again. What a great team – our thanks.
