We are celebrating the 25th anniversary of the thrift store with the opening of our new addition. We have enclosed the back patio area and now have an area that will stay clean and dry! This space will be for larger furniture, camping, gardening, beach items and other “stuff”. In the fall it will be an area for Christmas trees, holiday inflatables and large decorative items. Our thanks to Midwest Construction and Will Clark Electric for completing this project with much supervision by staff and volunteers – sorry guys...

Feeding South Dakota has donated 6 shopping carts to the thrift store that allows a contact free donation process. The carts are placed in the back of the store and are labeled for various types of donations. Donors are able to pull up and unload their items without entering the store. Staff is still available for assistance and questions.

Please bear with us as we try to find the best balance of shopping and donation hours – you may have noticed that we have been without our inmate staff since March – that leaves a big gap – our staff (including some prior staff members) and volunteers have really stepped up to the plate to keep things flowing as smoothly as possible but it does mean we have to limit our hours. Recently we had a customer call the office to schedule a shopping appointment at the thrift store – when asked if he had shopped before he said yes, when asked if he knew the drill he responded “yep, wear a mask and be good”.

That’s all we ask these days, wear a mask and be good.

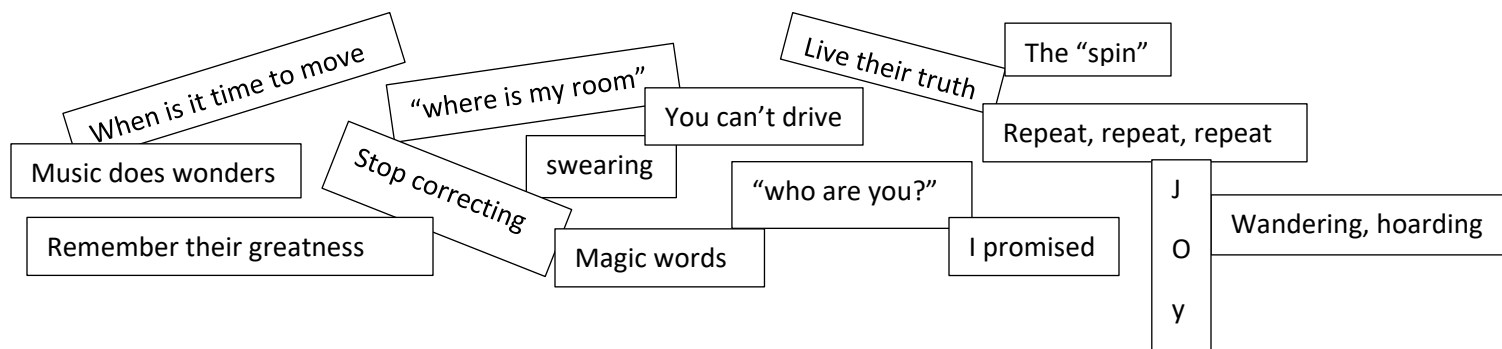
Pennies for Robert

Each month – with your help – Countryside provides travel funds for cancer patients who need to travel into Pierre or out of Pierre for their treatment. In June 2020 we provided **\$6,985** in funds bringing the total amount distributed since April to **\$21,685**. These funds come directly from donations, thrift store sales and special fundraisers such as *Rally for Robert*. All of this is done in memory of Robert Disburg, all of this made possible by you.
