In the past two months you have made the following possible:

6 guests have spent 26 nights at St Benedict's Guest House at no charge

The Memory Center has provided 10 memory screens for new patients and 16 tests for returning patients <u>and</u> scheduled the first Memory Clinic for Gettysburg in July <u>and</u> provided a support group setting for 16 family members/caregivers.

\$13,317 was donated to Avera@Home Hospice - this donation is used for additional nursing and home health aide visits, special equipment and supplies and non-emergency ambulance transfers. Extra funds = extra care!

\$15,040 in travel funds was provided for cancer patients traveling to Pierre or leaving our community for chemo, radiation, consultations, follow up visits or surgery. No income requirements – no paperwork to fill out –

\$150 in thrift store vouchers were provided for individuals and families in need of clothing and household items. \$150 doesn't sound like much but remember they may get clothing for only 25¢ so a dollar goes a long way!

All of this was made possible through memorials and donations we have received at the office and the thrift store donations and sales. Approximately **\$42,657** in community services – in just two months – because of you –
