In 1983 when we did the first Tree of Lights it was an effort to honor the memory of hospice patients, share information about Countryside and hopefully do a little fund raising. We were a small, new program with a lot of passion for the mission but no guaranteed income. Each month felt like a giant leap of faith as we moved forward, serving patients, gaining volunteers and doing every fund raiser known to man.

It felt like the right thing to do and with your help we pushed on.

That November we decided we would put up a Christmas tree and for each donation received during the holidays we would add a new light – Keith Crandell graciously offered the window at the Shoe Tree – we put up a modestly sized tree, Sarah turned on the first light for her dad Kris and we were off. Each day we would add lights to the tree – this was 1983 so we are talking large, screw in, too hot to handle lights – soon the tree was covered and we started around the window, and then expanded to the second window – and the sleepless nights started as we dreamed of burning down Main Street. All for a good cause.

Fortunately, Christmas lights have evolved and the fire hazard concerns have faded. We now add an ornament for each donation along with the name of the donor or their loved one. Each year there are new names mixed in with the familiar ones from the past – a tree covered with your memories. A reflection of your generosity.

This year the tree is at the thrift store – just inside the door. It is a little sacred space amid all the chaos of the season, a quiet reminder of what is important this time of year.

Hopefully, over the next few weeks as you stroll the halls of the Capitol to view the brightly decorated trees you will take a moment to read the plaques on each one – you may be struck by how many programs are doing good things for the community – Governor's Grocery Program, PARS Holiday Feast Fund, Suicide Prevention and Awareness, Avera @ Home Hospice, the Cancer Care fund in Philip, just to name a few. Examples of people recognizing a need and moving forward to make a difference.

The Christmas spirit in action – thank you for making all of this possible.
