Hello from Countryside -

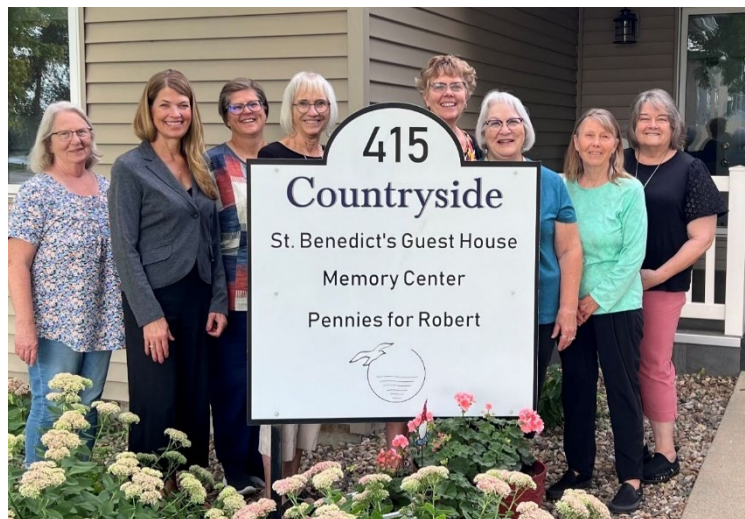
