The guest house is nearing completion and as with any project, there are a million final details. Our goal is to be ready to provide lodging for cancer patients receiving treatments at the Helmsley Center by mid-September. We hope you can attend the open house. Your donations have created a homelike environment that will hopefully be welcoming and comforting for the patients and their families.

Once again you have stepped up to the plate and filled a need ... thank you.

In addition to celebrating the guest house we are also celebrating several other milestones:

- 2019 is the 120th anniversary of the Benedictine sisters arriving in Pierre. It would be hard to detail all that the sisters have contributed to our community. Many of us in healthcare remember the days when the sisters were in every department in St. Mary's and many of the classrooms at St. Joe's. They also served at the Women's Prison, and advocated for those in need. Their dedication, mentoring and friendship will never be forgotten.
- In September, Countryside celebrates their 39th anniversary. With incredible community support the program has grown in directions we never could have imagined.
- Another huge milestone is the completion of screening test #1000 by the Memory Center team. When the program started in 2011, we anticipated we would do about 40 screens per year – we were a little off on our projections!
Thanks to the support of the medical community, our incredible team and consulting physician Dr Pinholt, the Memory Center has spent thousands of hours with patients and their families. Thanks to the community this has all been done at no charge.

Volunteers needed

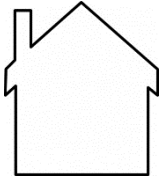

Back to school

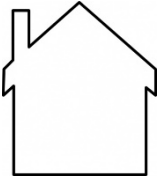
