BEHAVIOUR POLICY

Respect and Courtesy:

- a. Students are expected to show respect towards their instructors, fellow students, and staff members at all times.
- b. Use polite language and gestures when communicating with others.
- c. Avoid disruptive behaviour that may interfere with the learning environment or the enjoyment of others.

Punctuality and Attendance:

- a. Students are expected to arrive on time for all classes, rehearsals, and performances.
- b. Notify the school in advance if unable to attend a class or rehearsal.
- c. Excessive absenteeism may result in the student being unable to participate in performances or other events.

Dress Code:

- a. Students must adhere to the school's dress code which will be communicated to them.
- b. Dress appropriately for each class, rehearsal, or performance, ensuring that attire is suitable for the activity.

Safety:

- a. Students must prioritize their own safety and the safety of others during classes, rehearsals, and performances.
- b. Follow all safety instructions and guidelines provided by instructors and staff.
- c. Report any potential hazards or unsafe situations to a staff member immediately.

Confidentiality and Professionalism:

- a. Students must maintain confidentiality regarding any personal or sensitive information shared by fellow students, instructors, or staff.
- b. Conduct oneself in a professional manner when interacting with others, both inside and outside of the school environment.
- c. Avoid engaging in any behavior that may damage the reputation of the school or its members.

Behaviour Policy

Personal Belongings:

- a. Students are responsible for their personal belongings.
- b. Label all personal items with the student's name to avoid confusion or loss.
- c. The school is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
- d. Any items that are left at the end of the term will be disposed of.

Consequences:

a. In case of any violation of the behaviour policy, the school may take appropriate disciplinary action, which can include verbal warnings, written warnings, suspension, or expulsion, depending on the severity and frequency of the behaviour.

This behaviour policy aims to ensure a safe, respectful, and productive learning environment for all students at Baila con Cameron. By adhering to these guidelines, students can create a positive atmosphere and enhance their own growth and development in their artistic pursuits.



CHILD PROTECTION POLICY

We believe that no child or young person should be the subject of neglectful or abusive behaviour. We will promote and maintain the welfare of every child in our care and seek to protect them from harm regardless of race, age, disability, gender, sexual orientation, religious belief or any other form of identity or creed. We will create a safe and welcoming environment for all.

This policy applies to all out staff/
volunteers/cover teachers and covers anyone
who works under the Baila con Cameron
umbrella. This Policy is in effect to protect
children under the age of 18 and/or vulnerable
adults under the age of 25.

To protect children and young people in our care, we will:

- Value and respect children and listen to what the have to say
- Work with children, parents and relevant organisations
- Share our policy with all staff, parents and students
- Ensure all required checks are made when hiring staff and that those in regular contact with children hold the required security checks according to Spanish law.
- Provide appropriate training and support to all staff
- Take responsibility for children and young people's safety when in our care
- Seek permission from parents before taking images (photographs or film) of students and inform them how and where the images will be used
 - Report suspected neglect or abuse to the nominated member of staff, relevant organisation, or police.
- Ensure that this policy is regularly updated

Concerns regarding a child's welfare can be reported by:

- Parents
 Teachers
 Friends
 - The child or young person

All allegations of neglect or abuse will be taken seriously. If a concern is reported directly by the child or young person we will not seek to disagree, ask probing or leading questions, or do anything else which may discourage them. We will make it clear that reported concerns cannot be kept confidential, but will need to be shared with a nominated member of staff or external organisation. Parents or guardians will also be involved if appropriate.

We recognise that early action is vital. Any concerns will be reported immediately. If the child or young person is in immediate danger of harm, we will contact the police. In all other cases, we will report concerns to the Local Protection Team.

We will also seek to find all policies applying to child protection from any studios/rooms/theatres we choose to hire.

PHOTOGRAPHY/VIDEO & SOCIAL MEDIA POLICY

Permission to take/share/use photo & video

Students at Baila con Cameron will be involved in activities where they may be photographed. Photographs and videos of students may be used in a variety of ways from helping to rehearse show routines, preparing for dancing exams, celebrating a student's success or promoting Baila con Cameron

Please let Baila con Cameron know in writing if you **do not** want your child's photo to be taken or published, if we do not receive written communications we understand we have permission to photograph your child in alignment with our photography policy. Permissions can be changed anytime with written communication.

Social Media Photo/Video Policy

Baila con Cameron takes your child's safety and privacy very seriously and that is why your child will never be named or other details shared about them on any photos or videos shared. Unless we wish to share in an occasion or celebrate your child in which case your permission will be asked before anything is posted and you hold the right for this to be removed at any time.

The same rules do apply for both staff and the general public and please do seek permission before posting/sharing or taking photos of your child where other dancers/students appear.

General Public photography/video during outdoor classes

We do not encourage/permit videos or photos of our classes by outside parties however we will not disrupt the class/workshop or event to stop this from happening. Due to being in a public space, this third party is breaking no rules/laws. However, we will do our best to discourage this third party from filming, taking photos etc...

Should a member of the class wish to film a short section for personal use we ask that you obtain permission from anyone who may appear in the film and do not disrupt the class by doing so.

Equally, should you wish to stop a member of the public filming please do so with respect and kindness as it is a reflection of Baila con Cameron. In this case please refer them to our own Instagram/Facebook to see pictures/videos etc...
