Wild boar are experts at foraging for natural food.

Please DO NOT feed them.

Under normal circumstances wild boar are extremely cautious of human visitors and tend to be secretive; encouraging them with food will not only make them more susceptible to disease it may cause them to become desensitised to the presence of people. If they begin to lose their natural flight instinct this will only have a negative impact on the wild boar population.

If you are lucky enough to encounter a wild boar in the wild, of course observe this special animal, but please DO NOT feed them. By leaving them alone and allowing them to remain the cautious, secretive wild animals they are you will be helping to secure their safety, and their future, in the forests and the woodlands of the UK.
