Introduce a neutral design that aligns with the existing epoxy terrazzo flooring. Maintain consistency by using the same epoxy terrazzo flooring in the elevator cabins.

#### Accent Wall: West Wall

Transform the west wall into a striking accent feature. Creating a warm-up design with wood slabs.





Lenti's work is characterized by the use of high-quality materials and artisanal production techniques that ensure the durability and comfort of her products.


Her collections stand out for their minimalist aesthetics and vibrant colors, bringing timeless elegance to any space.

Her work embodies a fusion of creativity, sustainability, and luxury in the realm of high-end outdoor and indoor design.










