



- Welcome
- Winterfest Party (Kathy, Melissa, Hap)
 - Snacks update...current counts:
 - ~880 chips
 - ~783 tree cakes
 - 300 brownies
 - Lots of cookies
 - Lots of fruit snacks
 - = ~3,500 snacks
 - We have ~1,700 students
 - Volunteer sign-up (thanks, Hap!)
 - Gift card for Mr. Aiello – (Melissa H. purchased)
 - Inflatables have been ordered
 - Staff to validate volunteers are CMS-approved
 - Krissy ordering handwarmers
 - Day of the event supplies: volunteer stickers, tables, sharpies, volunteer sign-in sheet, hand-warmers.

 - Cards for the winners...need to give out next week

 - Ms. Dixon asking if we can buy the Media Center a vacuum.
 - We could use her \$100 reimbursement to help purchase
 - Aim for \$250 for cost for vacuum
 - Approved by the board during the meeting

 - Gift cards for teachers....students dropping off at the front office....give to Kathy

- Honor Roll – February 6th will be the recognition event.
 - Krissy will be working on food, etc. in January
- International Night – Keiko Wray: February 12th
 - PTSO will reimburse families up to \$50 for each country represented which will help offset the cost of food, supplies, etc.
 - Sabrina to provide a cut-off date for reimbursement (likely spring break)

 - Need to remind teachers to submit their reimbursements to Sabrina
 - Start transitioning after the new year
 - Sabrina to check that previous PTSO debit cards have been cancelled
 - School Store...was going to try to open before the holidays.
 - Sold a few items during the last Character Ed breakfast
 - Tchotchke sold really well around Valentine's Day
 - Likely will need an order to get some items in stock
- Principal Updates (Mr. Bissinger)
 - 5th grade students will be touring the Bailey Middle School in late January. Each elementary school gets their own day.
 - Kathy will ensure we have volunteers helping with scanners these days
 - Feb. 3rd at 6pm – Parent Night for 5th grade Cornelius & Davidson
 - Krissy and/or Kathy to present about PTSO
