 - Melissa to follow-up with Jennifer regarding whether or not the student who won the \$1,000 scholarship has cashed the check

- Fundraising Updates (Nicole Monacell & Morgan Williams)
 - Pajama Fundraiser
 - \$50 for the PJ's and rights to wear them every Friday starting in January
 - Already sold \$1,500 (revenue), profit will be about 50% of that
 - Parents can request to pick up PJ's in the office (so they can be a gift)
 - Continue to promote the PJ's
 - In the Bronco Times
 - A flier with QR code next week advertising
 - We could place a few fliers for the PJ's at the Honor Roll breakfast
 - Book Fair
 - 6th grade dance
 - The glow sticks will work better if it is dark, so best to select a date before daylight savings (which is March 10th)
 - Need to check the date of the 7th / 8th grade dance (which is run by the performing arts booster club)

- Spring Fundraiser: consider an idea like Cornelius Celebrates the Arts
