

- Welcome
- PTSO Positions Update (Krissy Lenkaitis & Kathy Epperson)
 - o Most chair and co-chair positions are now filled
- Fundraising Updates (Melissa McLead)
 - o Capital Campaign (1,700 students...likely under 200 transactions)
 - Campaign ends 10/22
 - \$11,500 raised so far via Capital Campaign
 - Reached approximately ¼ of \$50K goal last Friday
 - Fixed process issue with getting to Square for payments
 - Overall winning homerooms earn parties
 - Last year raised \$17K profit with Bronco Discount Cards
 - Ideas for increasing participation
 - Send blurbs to teachers for them to push out to their homeroom parents
 - o Stephanie can make a sign with the thermometer showing progress. Could include QR code
 - o Hand fliers with QR code in the car rider line to parents. (Melissa, Krissy, Stephanie?, who else?) Need date.
 - o Could offer ice cream on the playground to all students who have a donation at any time during the campaign qualify for ice cream. (So parents won't want their student to miss it)
 - o Add it to announcements after the Pledge of Allegiance

- o 6th grade Dance (updates starting in a few months)
- o 8th grade yard sign fundraiser (updates starting in the spring)
- Beautification (Lisa Price)
 - o \$873 for beautification budget this school year
 - o Would like to get some décor for the holidays (winter/snowflakes, wreaths, etc.)
 - o For fall, pumpkins are ok inside or if outside then keep by the front doors....not too close to the street
 - o Planning to plant pansies for the winter

 - o \$30 Student Fee update:
 - School supplies + student fees = \$2880. 830 students paid so
 ~50% of student population have paid student fees.
 - Payment comes through online store. So not sure who manages the payment component of the website? (Lisa?)
 Recommend taking off the donation from the student fee.
 Could improve the student fee section of website
 - o Taxes completed
 - o Teachers pay \$5 and get \$95 back
- Principal Updates (Mr. Bissinger)
 - Progress reports on Infinite Campus (not on paper this year)
 - Walkers and bikers now have a pass. Helps with Police
 Department and CMS. We now have over 150 bikers!
 - Reminder for parents to teach their biking students to follow the rules of the road
 - CMS hired an additional officer to be down Bailey Road to help with traffic
 - o Curriculum night. Great turnout for 6th grade
 - Clubs will kick-off in second quarter. Will start the first Friday of November
 - o Busses are a problem. CMS is short on drivers
 - Submit via CMS Transportation for request for changes
 - 1,695 students. 1 open counselling. EC teacher assistant position was just approved
