- Back to School Picnic (Melissa Hart, Holly Sun)
  - o 9/29 from 4:30pm 6:15pm
  - o Food Trucks:
    - Hungry Howie's pizza (\$4 per slice, \$3 for a soda)
    - Kona Ice (\$4, \$5, \$6 based on size)
    - Both giving back 25%
    - Both take debit cards and cash
