- Welcome
- Meeting Minutes Approved
- 2020-2021 PTSO budget was approved.
 - All positive except for one person that said the PTSO needed to spend more on students.
- Scholastic Dollars Update
 - Nicole ordered items before our dollars expired. The items have not come in yet.

Principal: Chad Thomas

- School Update
 - Bailey is still scheduled for the A, B, C student rotation to begin on Monday, November 23. This can still change.
 - Decided that students can move safely through the halls so they can switch classes and go to electives, instead of keeping them in one classroom the entire day.
 - Students will eat lunch in their classroom instead of gathering in the cafeteria.
 - PA time will be staggered, and students will be assigned quadrants to adhere to safety protocols.
 - Hallways have been marked with arrows and roundabouts have been created so will have flow throughout the school to adhere to safety protocols.
 - Will stagger class times so hallways will not be crowded to adhere to safety protocols.
 - Daily schedule will be adjusted to include 45 minutes of Thunder Time. This will give us time to get everyone in the building safely and perform the temperature checks.
 - Will also stagger pick up in the afternoon to adhere to safety protocols.
 - Will release one bus at a time.
 - Car riders will stand on spots. Spots will extend down to the gym so we can safely spread out the students while they wait to be picked up.
 - We are having a challenge getting the kids to stay online for classes.
 - The number of A/B Honor Roll students for 1st Quarter is down. Approximately 500 students, instead of the usual 900.
 - There will be no block rotation for 2nd quarter classes.
 - We will still have the year-end EOC tests for the Math 1 and Math 2 classes as we need to make sure the students are ready for their next math class (Math 2 & Math 3).
 - There is a need for paper towels for teachers/classrooms when the students come back in November.
- Hill Update
 - Have not heard back from Mint Landscaping.
 - CMS will hydro seed.
 - We will purchase the hydro matting.

- Cash on Hand as of 9/30/20 is \$19,360.25
- Reviewed Monthly Activity:
 - Still receiving money from Bronco Fund Donations
 - \$850 from 12 donors
 - YTD total is \$3,355 from 79 donors
 - Still receiving money from Student Fees
 - 135 paid in September-\$3,110
 - YTD total is \$15,193 from 692 donors
 - Need to push student fees when students return in November

- o Online School Store is doing well
 - Sold \$215 worth of merchandise in September
- o Harris Teeter VIC card
 - \$299 check received
- o Sales Tax Refund
 - \$245.62 check received
- o Expenses:
 - Made final payment to Bailey for student agendas
- Upcoming Activity:
 - o Amie received new PTSO checks and can begin to reimburse staff/faculty for various items such as webcams.
 - o Staff/faculty PTSO membership dues
 - For month of September, 3 staff members sent in \$5 fee.
 - Are we asking for dues from staff this year?
 - Answer is Yes. We will tie it to reimbursement for classroom supplies
 - Will set up a google form and offer Amazon, Target, or Staples gift card to choose from.
 - o Does the PTSO want to purchase welcome back banners and/or mask lanyards for the students when they come back to school in November? Will look into the cost and make a decision.

VP Fundraising: Nicole Monacell

- Virtual Scholastic book fair will be held online November 2-15.
 - o Proceeds to Bailey PTSO.
 - o Link will be in the Bronco Times.
 - o Items will be mailed directly to family's homes, will not have to pick up at school.
- School store will order more hoodies and Bronco face masks.
- Scoreboard Update
 - o Waiting on a quote.
 - o Chad is leaning toward a 90'-100' commercial grade monitor instead of a traditional scoreboard.
 - o Will reach out to Samsung to see if they would be willing to work with us.
 - o We might be able to use \$500 from the Athletic Booster Fund towards purchase.

- TV monitors for classrooms
 - o Best deal is \$130 for a nice 40" monitor.
 - o Currently need 70-75 monitors, including mounting brackets.
 - o Nicole will send out letter to businesses and write an article for the Bronco Times to ask for \$150 to sponsor the purchase of a monitor. Sponsors will be recognized on the PTSO website, Bronco Times, and with a plate with their name on the monitor.

 - o Will plan a drive-through event for all Q1 A/B Honor Roll students to get their certificates.
 - o Looking at Thursday, Oct 29.
 - o Will look into having an ice cream truck to give honor roll students a treat.
- Character Ed Awards
 - o Chad will do a slideshow with a voice over.
 - o Will plan a drive-through event for the students to get their certificates and a treat.
 - There will be 52 Character Ed students (4 per team, 13 teams).
 - o Will look into a Tenders gift certificate and a pencil or chick n' minis.
