

Modified Bailey Student Schedule – Daily Asynchronous Blocks

Starts September 1, 2020

As we begin to plan for a future return to in-person learning, we want kids to get accustomed to working through their Canvas course assignments without a direct virtual meeting with a teacher (asynchronous assignments completed on their own). This schedule modification will also reduce screen time for our students every Tuesday-Friday in one class per day. Students should be able to complete their asynchronous work independently for that specific class in 30-40 minutes at any point throughout the day that works best for their schedule. Teachers will be available through email to assist students on these days and will be contacting students individually as the need for extra support arises.

- Please reference the schedule below as a simple EXAMPLE of 6th grade, yet this will differ by grade and by student. All students in 6th, 7th, and 8th will have an asynchronous (independent) block daily in one of their core subjects as listed below.
- Tuesday - ELA / Wednesday-Math / Thursday - Science / Friday - Social Studies
- Their current class schedule and times DO NOT change!
- Please note that teachers will review this new schedule with students, remind students the day before their asynchronous class, and post reminders in Canvas.
