- Fundraising Updates (Melissa McLead)
 - Capital Campaign
 - 1706 students at Bailey Middle School
 - 876 families donated to the Capital Campaign
 - Considering a second campaign in second semester
 - Next year, consider starting Capital Campaign in time for Open House / Bronco Round Up
 - Consider the presidents of athletics booster club, arts booster club, PTSO to coordinate dates for fundraising campaigns
 - Dining Nights Out

 - February 27th
 - Tickets - \$25, cash only

 - Students can hang out with friends after eating snack
 - In spring, considering ice cream truck. (Very fast process to distribute ice cream.) \$3 per ice cream, so a great price
 - Character Awards (Kathy Epperson)
 - The last Character Award day was Friday and was well-attended.
 - ACE Awards
 - January 30th in the afternoon
 - Kathy needs the number of students earning the ACE award so she can purchase all of the snacks. (Sometimes needs to go to multiple stores to get enough of the snack.)
- Knights Game Day Opportunity on April 23 for local area

- Teacher Appreciation (Jessica Wolfe)
 - February 11th will be the next event which is the early release day. Jessica is getting most of the food sponsored.

- International Night (Keiko Wray)
 - 8 countries signed up so far.
 - 15 countries last year, and 23 countries the year before
 - \$50 reimbursement for participating families with a receipt. (This offsets the cost of the food.)
 - Student incentive:
 - Students who volunteer to support the event can increase one Q3 Rehearse grade to 100% for any class.
 - Students who participated and received above the minimum number of passport stamps can increase one Q3 Social Studies Rehearse grade to 100%
 - Send separate parent square message so we get more families to sign up and students attend the event
 - Keiko is working with Ms. Schneider to ask NHJS student volunteers to hand out passports.
 - Could include Hough student international clubs, but they must have a parent or advisor chaperone
 - We have the passport stamps from last year
