- Budget Review (Sabrina Huffman)
  - See Treasurer's Report
  - Annual Student Fee: 992 have paid
  - Teachers can have until spring break as a deadline for requesting funds
  - Taxes
    - 2023 taxes have been filed
    - The PTSO currently has a \$1,900 tax bill because the new PTSO wasn't filed with the IRS as a non-profit when it was first formed
      - Requesting CPA to file a form to fight it
  - Accounting comments
    - PJ Fundraiser will be filed under the "spring fundraiser" line item in the budget
    - Inflatables for winter party will be filed under the Back to School picnic (from Jumpstart)
  - We earned \$513 from Harris Teeter reward last school year
  
- Fundraising Updates (Liz Mills )
  - Bronco discount cards
    - \$35,692 in revenue
    - Expense will be ~ 50%
    - ~\$17,846 in profit

- PJ fundraiser
  - \$50 for PJ's to wear on Fridays
  - Cannot wear the same PJ's as last year
  - November 29<sup>th</sup> will be the last day to order PJ's
  - PJ's will arrive the last week of school before the Winter Break
  - Students will also get a PJ pass
  - Students can wear these PJ's on Fridays starting in January
- Book Fair
  - Amy Vaughn will run the book fair
  - Trish to connect with Amy to see if we can have the book fair the week of February 17<sup>th</sup>
- Hornets Night – January 24<sup>th</sup>
  - Fundraiser
  - If we sell enough tickets, the Hornets will try to do something fun for the Bailey students
- 6<sup>th</sup> grade dance
  - We can get a committee with parents of 6<sup>th</sup> graders to run it
- School Support
  - Honor Roll: (Krissy)
    - After first semester and after 3rd quarter
    - For A or A/B honor roll
    - Full year honor roll to have some special recognition
    - "A honor roll" will still get a certificate

- Staff Appreciation (Trisha)
  - Thanksgiving staff event
    - In media center; will need four tables
    - Sign-up Genius just went out for parents
  - December staff event
    - Recommending a staff holiday party similar to last year (since it had great turn-out)
    - Maybe Wednesday, December 18<sup>th</sup>

- Winter Party
  - Thursday, December 19<sup>th</sup>
  - Each grade level will have their own party timeslot
  - Will run very similar to the Back to School Picnic
  - Inflatables from Jumpstart
  - However, no outside vendors (no pizza or ice trucks)
  - No cost for extra police support since during the school day
  - Mr. Aiello will DJ the party; Melissa has PTSO gift card for him
  - In early December, send a Sign-up Genius:
    - Request a small number of parent volunteers for each class party to monitor inflatables, etc.
    - See if grade-level reps can be an on-site lead for their respective grade-level parties
    - Request packaged snacks to be donated for the parties – need to think about some good options (???)
