MICROCHIPPING:

Microchipping is a simple, safe, and effective way to ensure pets can be identified and returned to their owners if lost because 1 in 3 pets will go missing in their lifetime. Unlike collars or tags, microchips are permanent and can't be removed or lost. Keeping your contact information updated in the microchip registry is crucial for it to work effectively.
