- All horses must be shown to all 4 judges to be eligible for any award (VRH horses must show to both judges)
- Halter points will count but are not mandatory.
- You must show **at least 3 AQHA categories per judge** for all arounds (except 11&Under walk/jog)
- Only AQHA classes will count for all arounds (except all-breed walk/jog).
- All Youth & Amateur exhibitors – 1 horse/1 rider

Circuit Awards in All AQHA classes

- Circuit awards in all classes! To qualify for Circuit Awards, you must show to all judges.
- AQHA divisions may not be combined for awards. You may show in all divisions for which you are eligible. Points for circuit awards will be figured on a 9-8-7-6-basis with 9 being the most points earned under 1 judge. AQHA points are not added. If less than 9 horses show in a class, points will decrease accordingly.
- Highest Score awards for Trail, Working Cowhorse, Roping, Reining and Ranch Riding will be based on single highest score. Ties will be awarded based on highest cumulative score.
- Again in 2025! Buckles for circuit awards in all cutting divisions! Thank you to our generous sponsors!

Awards will be announced at the horse show.

Please claim your awards as soon as possible after your class. Awards not claimed at the show will be forfeited. Show office staff cannot keep track of your points; please be sure to do that yourself. The office will track points for All Around & Circuit awards at this show only.

■ IN CASE of TIES ■

Winner for All Around will be determined by horse with most 1st place wins. If still tied the winner will be determined by a tie-breaker judge. Winner for Circuit Awards will be determined by a tie breaker Judge. In all cases, decisions of the AQHB of SCV show management will be final.

- All AQHA classes are conducted under AQHA rules
- **Move in begins** Tuesday, July 22nd, 2025.
- **Show fees, stall fees and RV/Camping fees** must be paid by cash or check (no credit cards).
- **Returned checks** will be assessed \$50.00 and must be made good with a cashier's check, money order, or cash, including penalty, within 10 days of notification or the matter will be turned over to AQHA for further action.
- **There will be no re-deposits.** If you have had a check returned by the bank, for any reason at this, or any PCQHA approved show, we reserve the right to require cash payment for entries, stalls, and any other fees.
- All Trail class entrants, and any horse schooled over trail obstacles, will be charged the obstacle fee.
- Stall refunds must be requested before July 17. NO stall refunds after July 17.
- In the event a pre-entered horse or rider is sick or hurt, we will refund entry fees upon receipt of a Doctor or Veterinarian certificate, on their official letterhead, ONLY. No refunds for any other reason. No refunds of cattle fees. Request must be submitted within 30 days of close of show.
- **Gelding owners** – if you have not had your horse's registration papers corrected, bring the originals and have them changed at the show - no fee.

AQHB of SCV Show Rules and Reminders

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF EXHIBITORS TO KNOW THE AQHA RULES

If you have any questions, we're here to help

RULES

- **NO STALLIONS** are allowed in any YOUTH Classes or in any L1 Amateur Classes
- **AQHA RULES** will prevail in all AQHA Classes
- **ALL ENTRIES AND SCRATCHES MUST BE DONE IN THE OFFICE, PRIOR TO CLASS**
- **GATE SCRATCHES WILL NOT BE CREDITED**
- NO Numbers will be issued until registration papers and AQHA memberships have been verified by the show secretary. Be sure your papers show the correct owner. Signed transfers &/or computer print-outs are not acceptable as proof of ownership or membership. All exhibitors must have a current AQHA membership in his or her name ONLY. If you do not have one, you can purchase it at the horse show. Photo copies of registration papers and AQHA membership cards are acceptable. If your horse has been gelded and the papers still say Stallion, we can stamp the originals for you at the show at no charge.
- Select Amateurs may begin showing in the Select classes on their 50th birthday. You may NOT show in Select & Amateur with the same horse. You MAY show Novice and Select with the same horse.
- 11 & Under Walk/Jog classes are open to any breed of horse and there are no ownership or membership requirements. You may not enter classes calling for a lope or canter, but you may show in AQHA showmanship and/or halter classes in which case, all AQHA rules will apply.
- If you enter an AQHA Walk/Jog or Walk/Trot class you cannot enter the corresponding AQHA 3-gait class.
- Roping jackpots are optional for Open & Amateur roping. You are not in the jackpot unless you declare otherwise before your first roping class. Jackpots will be paid daily to top two fast times, split 60/40. Checks will be mailed 6-8 weeks.
- Remember the AQHA Performance Horse Halter classes are All Age classes. You may not show the same horse in Performance Halter and traditional halter classes on the same day. VRH classes do not count as the performance class for Performance Halter eligibility.
- Per AQHA Show Rule #SH100-7, the Exhibitor must accurately complete entry forms and assumes responsibility for any errors

REMINDERS

- When listing your classes on the entry form, you will be entered for all days unless you note otherwise.
- Please pick up your awards at the awards table right after your class. Do not wait until you check out, you may forfeit them. We are not able to mail or otherwise deliver awards after the show.
- The office staff cannot keep track of your points, you must do that yourself. They will track points for All Around & Circuit awards at this show
- Remember credit cards are welcome at many of the on-site vendors and at Country Hills Feed, but the office cannot accept credit cards for payment of show fees, stall fees, or RV/camping fees.
- Drones and other remote-controlled devices are not allowed on the show grounds
- Remember to slow down when riding your bicycle on the show grounds or around horses
- **The fairground management requires that ALL DOGS be on a leash and under the control of a responsible person. Animal control will patrol the grounds & impound loose dogs. Please, keep your dogs away from the food areas, arena gates & horses.**

▪ PLEASE ▪

All horse trailers not being used as living quarters must be parked in the designated parking lot. All lanes must be kept clear for fairgrounds equipment, emergency vehicles, and drive-ins. No trailer parking between or in front of the barns or along road ways in barn area. Please plan ahead by ordering an extra tack room, if necessary.

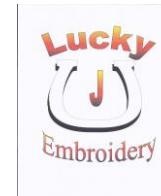
