

Framing Foreman Job Description

The position we are currently hiring is a leader experienced in wood-frame, two-story construction including: wall framing, TGI installation, RC Channel install, truss install, stick frame roof framing, install venting for dryer and over-the-range microwave, install insulation, install all windows and exterior doors, sheet building, sheet roof to lock up, build stair cases, install soffit and fascia, build the covered seating areas, install poolhouse benches, install HVAC unit ground screens and be experienced at working at heights. This is a rewarding opportunity for the right candidate who can create a productive crew. We are an equal opportunity employer.

Number of positions we are hiring for: 1 or 2 - we may do one framing crew per building side (one 2-bedroom unit crew, and one 3-bedroom unit crew, not yet decided)

Skills you **MUST** have to be considered for this position:

- Must have at least 3 years experience of framing crew supervision
- Must be detail oriented with analytical thinking and organizational system
- Must have a good ability to utilize materials with minimal waste
- Able to read and interpret blueprints/plans
- Do a layout and estimate of all materials needed
- Coordinate materials prior to delivery
- Communication with site administration of owner supplied materials needing delivered to site
- Brief the crew prior to pour for safety and production
- Spotting for equipment operation
- **Have extensive experience with fall protection**
- Direct the crew during framing
- Direct and oversee the operation of powered and non-powered hand tools to construct:
 - Wall framing
 - TGI installation for second floor
 - RC Channel install
 - Truss install
 - Stick frame roof framing on dormers
 - Install venting for dryer and over-the-range microwave
 - Install insulation
 - Install all windows and exterior doors
 - Sheet building walls
 - Sheet roof to lock up
 - Construct staircase treads and landings
 - Install soffit and fascia
 - Frame the covered seating areas including posts and benches
 - Install poolhouse benches
 - Install HVAC unit ground screens
- Work with inspectors and management for framing inspection
- Organize the clean up and reset of all materials every day to
- Ability to help out with other onsite trades as necessary
