


Custom Laminate Seams & Joints


LAMINATE SEAMS:

- * Laminate seams with custom tops are needed due to laminate sheet size availability.
- * The largest size laminate is 60" x 144".
- * The largest assembled top for shipping is 72" x 168" overall.

Miter Seam




Laminate Seam@ Sink




MITERS & BUTT-JOINTS

- * Unassembled joints are required ease of handling, transportation and installation...
- * Use miter joints whenever possible, it helps eliminate front edge seam.
- * Always use water resistant wood glue when assembling joints to prevent water damage. Water damage is not covered under Counter Pro warranty.

Miters vs. Butt Joints:




Butt Joint on Right Return:




OFFSET MITER JOINTS

- * Use with Square Edge, wood edge or bevel edge.
- * Allows for longer lengths without additional joints/seams.
- * Eliminates front edge seam that would be visible with butt joint...

L-Shape w/Peninsula:




"U" Shape w/Peninsula:





Butt Joints for U-Shaped Custom Counter Tops


When cutting butt joints for custom self edge, custom wood edge and custom bevel edge. Counter Pro, Inc. Prefers to machine both sides of a joint for the smoothest fit for assembling the joint at a job site. The following drawing shows the areas on where to place a butt joint when it is close to a corner.



^{*} The Left side may be as close as 1 1/2" from the inside corner.

** The Right side must be a minimum of 12" away from the inside corner.


Note:




- Always keep joints away from the sink area or work area to help prevent water damage, which is not covered under warranty.
- Always use water proof wood glue when assembling any joint to help prevent water damage.
- Straight "laminate seams" must be placed a minimum of 3" in from each corner.




Custom Square Edge Fabrication Center







Note: Allow proper overhang for #1. #2, #3



- 1. Please be sure to provide the required information on all
- Allow proper overhang when ordering radius and clipped corners.
- 3. When supplying cabinet dimensions, please specify requested overhang; i.e., angle, end base, angle cuts
- 4. Make sure that you indicate whether dimensions given are cabinet or countertop.





Note: A 1" Overhang on the front, actually ends up 1 1/8" at the end point
