Fleas, Heartworms and Worms

The best products on the market for heartworm prevention contain **ivermectin**. Sentinel is a good product. Stay clear of Trifexis. It is proven to be dangerous even deadly to some dogs. Many dewormers, vaccines, etc. are mixed with another med to kill two birds with one stone (so to speak). I would suggest medicating using one drug at a time. If a dog were to have a reaction when using a dual med, you wouldn't know which med was causing the problem.
