WHAT A TEAM RECEIVES

- Online GOTR[®] experiential learning training for coaches and site liaison
- Coach training materials, including the evidence-based Coach Guide
- Online access to Coach GOTR[®] Learning Academy training modules
- Online access to supplemental coach resources
- GOTR[®] Curriculum use for one season
- GOTR[®] Curriculum supplemental Activities for girls for lessons for one season
- “Coach Box” containing the supplies required to deliver the season’s GOTR[®] Curriculum
- Ongoing support for the Site Liaison and Coaches

*For a variety of reasons, an offsite 5K event may not be an option; however, we will plan a celebration with you for the girls.

WHAT A SITE PROVIDES

- A safe outdoor running and activity area
- A safe indoor rain site
- A registered site liaison (can be one of the coaches)
- At least 2 registered coaches for 25 girls.
Coaches serve as role models for positivity and do not need to be runners or athletic. Coaches can be teachers, parents, staff, or community members - -whatever complies with the site’s policies. If you only have one coach, we will work with you to ensure your team is supported.
- A means to recruit the girls for your location
- Willingness to follow the GOTR season dates, including the running event, and attend GOTR coach trainings and meetings per season
- Approval from the administration to host GOTR
- A willingness to comply with GOTR and grant requirements

PAYMENT

Payment is being made through a generous grant from Prime Time* to our Council; therefore, **Prime Time requirements must be followed.**

No fee is required from the site or the families. (Note: The usual parent-pay fee is \$195 per girl, so this grant is a wonderful opportunity and tremendous value for your families and site.)



- Sites that participate in GOTR as part of this grant must have a **minimum of 15 girls in attendance at each session** (depending on social distancing guidelines) from **3rd to 5th grades**.
- In order to accomplish this minimum, up to 25 girls may be registered.
- A minimum of 10 weeks is required. A schedule will be discussed between the OST and ELO representatives.
- Any cancelled sessions must be re-scheduled and may lengthen the number of weeks needed to complete the curriculum.
- A parent or guardian should register their own girl in the GOTR online system, as waivers are required.
- Sites should be Title I populations new to GOTR and participate in Prime Time.



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
