**What is a birdie?** A birdie is a score of one stroke better than par for any golf hole. Par is the average expected score for any given hole (typically 3, 4, or 5). PGA pros are expected to make anywhere between 1,000 -1,500 birdies during The Classic.

The format is 72 Hole Stroke Play and will be played from **February 27 to March 2**. (*February 26 is deadline for guessing Birdies*) The course is PGA National Resort & Spa – Champion Course; Par 70; 7,110 Yards. Players come from around the globe.
