- 5. Scholarships in the amount of \$500 will be paid to the recipients' account at the respective college/university/technical school in which the student is enrolled after providing proof of enrollment for the academic year for which the award is made.
- 6. All funds must be utilized during the academic year for which the award is made, beginning with the Spring 2022 semester or Fall 2022 semester.
- 7. The Scholarship Committee has sole responsibility for selecting the scholarship recipient. All decisions of the Committee are final.
