

TMIWW Sewing Contest 2022

Make it With Wool is an annual youth centered sewing competition to promote the beauty and versatility of wool and mohair fabrics, yarns, and fibers. It encourages personal creativity in sewing, knitting, crocheting, spinning, weaving, and other needlework arts. We also host a "Texas Only" Fiber Arts Competition that encompasses other skills including sewing, felting, weaving, knitting arts and more. Wearable garments include weaving, knit, crochet and felting. National Rules Apply. Visit www.makeitwithwool.com for details.

PRIZES

All contestants receive wool fabric from TMIWW and Pendleton Woolen Mills in Portland, Oregon.

- Pre-Teen Winner receives a Serger given in memory of Lillian Wissemann.
- Junior and Senior Winners Receive a stipend towards their trip to the National MIWW Competition in January 2022. Location and dates to be announced.
- Adult Winner receives \$150 cash and submits an electronic entry to the National Contest. National finalists are eligible to attend the national competition.
- There are additional prizes for second place and specialty awards. Best Construction is chosen from any of the divisions and receives an Ott Sewing light.
- \$500 scholarship available to one 2022 contestant which will be attending college in the 2023-2024 school year; awarded by the Hill Country Sheep and Goat Organization, TSGRA and TMIWW.
- Mohair Award

Return the entry form and mail with material samples:

- Two 5" x 5" samples of each wool fabric
- Two 36" long samples of each yarn
- \$12 entry fee for each entry in all divisions
- Testing is free for all fabric or yarn for each entry in 2022.

- TMIWW is not responsible for late, misdirected or lost entries.
- To be eligible, a garment must have been completed after January 1, 2022.
- Entry form may be copied as needed. Use a separate form for each entry.
- Entry fees are non-refundable.
- Deadline for Garments is date of event. 2022 will be in-person.
