


### Service above Self

High Performance Leadership Project

- Original idea was \$10,000 project for one lifepump
- Ended up with a Global Grant project for \$110,000 including 4 solar power submersible water pumps, elevated storage tanks, 10 toilets, and training.
- Presented talks at 15 district 6690 clubs and at the Rotary 6690 fall district conference


# All Ohio President Elect Training
