Pi-Stone

The Pi or Medicine Stones (also known as donut stones) are circular in shape, with a hole in the middle. They are used as the gateway to the invisible world of the Earth keepers and the Laika. Pi stones date back to the Incas and are symbolic of our luminous bodies and the energetic universe. They are used as a hyper-dimensional access tool through invisible realms that the Laika and Earth keepers have access to.



You too may access these realms as a result of your initiation into the nine Rites of Munay-ki. Their geometric shape is called a Torus and they symbolize the circular path that the sun follows in the sky. The hole in the middle represents the principle of absolute oneness. It symbolizes the eternal unity of all things - the cycle of life, death

The Pi is also a representation of the human luminous energy field. It is the luminous Energy Field that surrounds and envelopes the physical body and is the blueprint for our

physical, emotional and spiritual selves. The Luminous Energy Field enters our Body through our feet and rises up through the core of the body along the spine and out through the very top of our heads. Then comes down the width of our outstretched arms, entering the earth for about a foot and rising up through our feet once again. Thus, it creates a donut shaped luminous structure that contains, envelops and informs us.

Pi stones are found throughout the Americas, vast quantities of them are in museums and no one knows what they were used for.

The Laika know that they are portals or gateways, they also know that they are simply stones and that you are the portal – you are they gateway.

When you become an access point to the hyper dimensional matrix of creation, your luminous energy field is unbound from time and you are no longer the effects only of your past, nor the events that occurred to you when you were twelve, when you were six, in a former life time, before you were born. You are the result of the future of your destiny reaching back like a giant hand propelling you into your becoming.

What is a Pi-Stone?

Pi stone is a small circular stone with a hole in the middle, also known as a torus (the three-dimensional shape of a doughnut).

Pi stones are a representation of your spiritual bodies, and the energy universe has to offer. They depict your light and brilliant energy field symbolically. A pi-stone serves as a portal, a trans-dimensional gateway to the energies you are tapping when using these rites, to transmit the Munay-Ki.



The Pi stone can also be seen as representing the ouroboros, the serpent of light which swallows its own tail, constantly creating itself in the form of a circle. The Ouroboros symbolizes the eternal unity of all things, the cycle of life, death and rebirth. In this context, the center of the Pi stone represents our energetic spine and the energy, which flows through the center of our bodies. There is yet a further connection to be made with our own spiraling DNA, the building blocks of life.

Selecting your pi-stone, or healing stone

Let it select you. You'll know it is right for your energy.

You can also use a hag stone. If you don't have a pi-stone or hag stone at the beginning of the course, activate and program your favorite healing stone.

How to activate a Pi-Stone

You may activate it by any of these methods:

- anointing it with oil,
- passing it through incense,
- leaving it in the light of a Full Moon, or
- by journeying with it in your hand and lifting it into the light of the Upper World.

Consecrate your healing stone

1. Take out your Pi Stone or Healing Crystal
2. Pass it over incense with the intention to clear any energies in it
3. Hold it in your non-dominant hand and focus your intention into it
4. Pass the stone over the palm of your dominant hand, inside of the wrist, inside of the arm, over the outside of same arm, and back to the hand filling it with your energy.
5. Hold it between both hands and whisper to it how you want it to behave, enhancing the healing energies every time you use it.
6. For the next 21 days, touch it at least every 3 days, adding your life force into it.
7. Do not allow anyone else to handle it

The meaning of the three breaths through the pi-stone:

The Q'ero often blow their breath through a sacred item like a pi-stone for example, during a rite transmission or across their mesa (their altar) three times to:

1. Connect our finest energies with the Great Spirit and the natural world.
2. Acknowledge the three worlds (upper world, middle world or this world; and the lower world). In this manner you are reminded and connected to your spirit team - your spirit animals, spirit guides, and birth angel.
and/or
3. Commit to the three ways of being (having the strength of the physical body; the will and intellect of the mind; and munay, the love and compassion of the heart).
