What are the 9 Munay-Ki Rites?

They are the nine great initiations of the Incan tradition. They bring a student into balance, or '*ayni*' (that is, right relationship) and encourage the key Incan attributes of Wisdom, Love and Service. They also serve to 'inform' their luminous energy field.

The first Four are the **Foundation Rites**

1. Healer's Rite - also a Lineage Rite
2. Bands of Power
3. Harmony Rite
4. Seer's Rite

Rite One: "Hampe" **Healers Rite** –

- Activates of our ability to positively affect the people and world around us
- Connects us to the lineage of Earthkeepers from the past who assist us in our personal healing
- Heals wounds of the past and of our ancestral line are during meditation and sleep time
- Connects you to a lineage of luminous beings; awakens the healer within.

Rite Two: **Bands of Power** Rite –

Five luminous belts that are woven into the luminous energy field for essential protection. this protection stays with you throughout your life.

When there is stress and challenges that affect you, the bands tear a little and you need to patch it up. This is done with a simple fire ceremony on the band you need to strengthen. You will learn how when you receive this initiation.

Rite Three: **Harmony** Rite –

- Transmission of the seven Incan Archetypes into the chakras. You will learn about the last three before the initiation.
- Helps you combust the psychic sludge that builds up in your chakras, so that your chakras can shine with their original light as you acquire a rainbow body.

Rite Four: **Seers** Rite –

- The Seers Rite is practiced in many different forms among the North Coast peoples of Peru, (the descendants of the Chimu and Moche cultures), and by the seers and trackers of the Amazon.
- Extra-cerebral pathways of light are installed that connect the visual cortex with the third eye and the heart chakra.
- Awakens your ability to perceive the invisible world of energy and spirit.

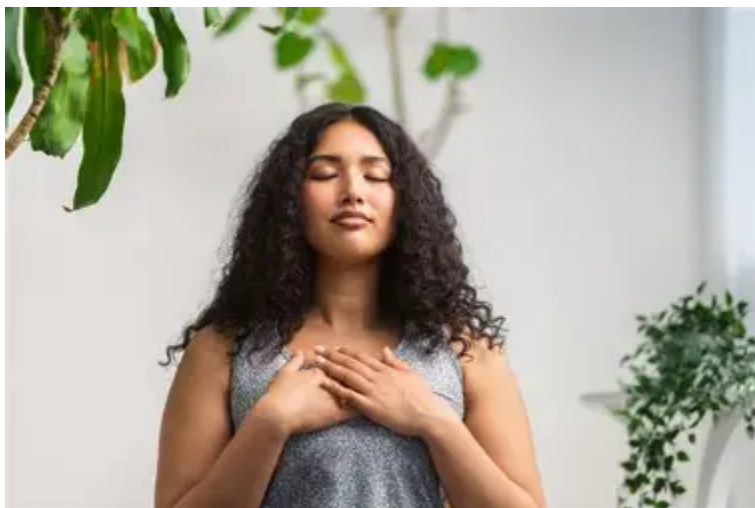
Lineage rites connect us to the medicine people who have come before us and establish the recognition of the spiritual journey we have undertaken. These medicine people were aware of their ability to impact those around them through their touch or presence. Lineage rites connect us to those that came before and allow us to receive the support and assistance of the healers of all time – past and future.

It also connects you to ancient altars, places of divine ceremony, and women healers of the past.

Connects you to a lineage of archangels that are the guardians of our galaxy.

THE SOURCES OF THE RITES OF THE MUNAY-KI

Rites of passage and initiations have been practiced for millennia by all peoples on the Earth. The rites of the Munay-Ki are based on initiatory practices of the Inka and pre-Inca shamans of the Andes and the Amazon.

The Healers Rite is known as the Hampe blessing and comes from the highland Q'ero people. The Bands of Power were transmitted by Juan Victor Nuñez del Prado, whose father was one of the original discoverers of the Q'ero nation.

The Harmony Rite comes from the lowland Q'ero, the Huachipayre people from the edge of the Amazon. Alberto Villoldo learned it from Don Alejandro Cahuanchi, a renowned healer.

The Seers Rite is practiced in many different forms among the North Coast peoples of Peru, (the descendants of the Chimu and Moche cultures), and by the seers and trackers of the Amazon.

The Daykeepers Rite is known among the Q'ero as the Pampamesayok, referring to the lowlands and valleys of the 'pampa', and to the mesa or altar.

The Wisdomkeepers Rite is known among the Q'ero as the Altomesayok rite, referring to the high mountains of the Andes. Don Manuel Quispe was the last great Altomesayok of Q'ero.

The Earthkeepers Rite is known among the Q'ero as the Kurak Akuyek rite, referring to the elder who 'masticates' the wisdom to nurture the young ones who follow.

The Starkeepers Rite is known as the Mosoq Karpay, which means the 'new rite' in the Quechua language. This rite announces and prepares one for the 'time to come.' The structure of Inka cosmology goes from the Earth (Pachamama) to the Mountains (Apu) to the Stars.

The Creator Rites are known as the Taitanchis rite. The word Taitanchis literally translates as 'God.' This was the last Rite transmitted in 2006, from there Alberto Villoldo was instructed to carry the Rites to the West.

"These rites are not only stages of initiation, but perhaps steps for the evolution of humanity. As nations fight for bits of territory and battle over land, we must find the wisdom to create peace among all peoples."

As our space telescopes show us images of a vast and immeasurable Universe, we must find a human story that is inclusive of the stars. And as our ability to destroy the world increases, we are called to step up to the task of assuming stewardship for all creation. In essence, the rites are about stewardship. They are not ego-awards or recognition of any kind of achievement, nor do they make anyone special. On the contrary, they make one uniquely unimportant.

Only then, from a position of no-ego, can we truly be of service. During their visits to the USA, the Inka pointed out that the rites were not for us individually; they were for others, to be shared. It has been my experience that they do not blossom unless we give them away with great Munay, with love.”

Gifting the Rites of Munay-Ki

Traditionally, initiates work with an elder for many years in sacred study before and between receiving rites of passage. However, we now stand at a time of quickening, a critical juncture of human history. Chaos abounds everywhere on our planet. The reason that these rites have been translated into an energetic form is so that these rites can be learned by many, and transmitted and replicated easily from person to person. It is hoped that these rites will be transmitted to as many individuals as possible now and in the coming times. While it is not a requirement for receiving the rites, it is asked that once you receive them that you strongly consider passing these rites along to others in a way that is comfortable for you. Like the concept of the hundredth monkey, as the rites mature in a core number of people on our planet, others will be drawn along into this new consciousness.

All initiates who undergo the nine rites of Munay-Ki are able to gift them to others. If you wish to make it part of your tool box, we recommend you to take the Shamanic Tools and Practices course that will teach many tools of healing, mentoring, and connecting to divine energy.

According to prophecy, we will then witness the birth of a new form of human on the planet and the dawn of a new civilization. You may view this course as an introduction and feel the need to study further. If so, meditate and connect so your transformational process is well served. I cannot stress enough that these Rites are universal ancient wisdom that have its roots in a great many traditions in our beautiful world.
