

Eastchester's 10th Annual Green Festival

Homegrown Produce Contest

Saturday, September 29th at Anne Hutchinson School

WHO: Open to youth and adults who reside in Town of Eastchester and the Villages of Bronxville and Tuckahoe

ENTRY REGISTRATION DEADLINE: Participants may register in advance via mail to reserve their entry, registration forms are for download from the Green Festival website or at the Eastchester Town Clerk's office. Entries will be accepted until noon on the day of the event, or until all spots are filled.

PROCESSING FEE: There's no entry fee

WHAT TO BRING: On the day of the contest bring your produce to Anne Hutchinson School before noon for check-in. Judging begins promptly at noon.

LIMIT OF ENTRIES: One entry per class per household; you may enter produce in multiple classes for each show.

JUDGING CRITERIA: All entries MUST be homegrown by the participant whose name appears on the entry form. Judging is based on appearance, size, texture, quality, taste and display of produce as appropriate.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded from 1st to 3rd place in each class.

CLASSES:

Class No.	Name	Requirements
1	Squash, all varieties including pumpkin	Provide 1 specimen
2	Tomatoes, all varieties	Provide 2 specimens
3	Peppers, all varieties	Provide 2 specimens
4	Greens, including chard, kale, kohlrabi, lettuce, spinach, etc	Provide 1 head or bunch
5	Root Vegetables, includes beets, carrots, onions, potatoes, radishes, turnips, etc.	Provide 2 specimens, tops on for all but potatoes
6	Beans, all varieties	Provide 5 specimens
7	Vegetable, other*	Provide 1 specimen
8	Largest Tomato	Provide 1 specimen
9	Misfit Vegetable, ugly, incredible, your choice	Provide 1 specimen. Judged by event attendees
10	Mixed Garden Vegetable Basket	Three or more different varieties of vegetables. Judged on creativity of display, and quality of produce. Basket provided by participant.

*classes without enough entries will be combined with the "vegetable, other" class
