#### NCIDENT NARRATIVE SUPPLEMENT NUMBER OFFENSE NCIDENT DATE Society ND TIME 2013 1531.02 This narrative supplement is a follow up to an Ohio Uniform Incident Report written by Officer Matt Hunt: On January 13, 2014 at 10:00am I met with Clinton County Municipal Court Prosecutor Laura Railings in regards to the information detailed below. I briefed her on the interviews that I conducted and she declined to approve charges against Robert Shumaker stating that there was a lack of evidence of a crime being committed. CASE CLOSED. I was assigned this investigation by Law Enforcement Supervisor Michele Welsh on 12/16/13. I was asked to contact the individuals below regarding the release of propagated deer by Robert Shumaker (DOB 03-05-1946). December 17, 2013 at 4:58pm I spoke with Steve Fisher. Mr. Fisher told me that he was at the Marathon Gas Station in Clarksville sometime during early summer 2013 and saw Robert Shumaker there. He spoke with Robert and they talked about various topics. Steve said that he asked Robert if he still had his deer and Robert replied that the gate was left open and the deer got out. Steve told me that Robert implied that the gate was left open intentionally but was not directly told by Robert that he left the gate open. I asked him how he implied it and he said it was just the way he said it. Steve said that Robert told him that the deer were tearing up his wife's flowers. I asked Steve if he would be willing to testify in court that Robert Shumaker intentionally released the deer and he said "no, because he didn't know for sure". December 17, 2013 at 5:06pm I left a voicemail with John Sewell asking him to call me. December 17, 2013 at 5:07pm I spoke with Tony Anderson and told him what I was investigating. Tony told me that his brother was the one that took the pictures of the deer with the ear tag in the ear. Tony told me that his brother did not have the pictures on his phone anymore. I asked him if he knew where the deer came from and he told me he thought Robert Shumaker. I asked him how he knew that and he told me that he heard from others in the neighborhood that it could be from Robert. I asked if he had any first hand knowledge that the deer was actually from Robert Shumaker's and he told me no. December 17, 2013 at 5:22pm John Sewell called me back. I explained to John that I was investigating the release of propagated deer into the wild by one of his neighbors. John was not aware of what I was talking about and told me that he did not know of any tagged deer being shot on his property. December 18. 2013 at 9:53am I spoke with Kevin Reynolds. Kevin told me that he was friends with Clint Shumaker. Clint is the son of Robert Shumaker. Kevin told me that he was at the Toby Keith bar in Cincinnati with Clint and Kevin asked about the deer that his dad had. Clint told Kevin that his dad had let the deer loose because they were getting too costly to take care of and have tested. Kevin said that he didn't think anything of it that it was just a conversation they had until he talked to Bobby Baughman. Kevin told me that Clint had a friend with him but Kevin couldn't remember the friend's name. This conversation took place sometime in early summer 2013. Kevin told me that he really would not want to testify against Clint since he is a friend. December 18, 2013 at 11:27am I spoke with Shannon Kearns/Shumaker and explained to them that I was conducting an investigation regarding propagated deer being released into the wild and was told that they may have information that would assist in the case. They both said that they did not have any idea what I was talking about. They told me they did not know of any deer being released into the wild and did not know anyone that had propagated deer. Shannon explained that they see alot of deer on their mail routes but not any propagated deer. December 18, 2013 at 3:19pm I spoke Wade Crady. He said that his father-in-law John Sewell called him and told him that

Wade told me that he is the caretaker of the property and has been for about 15 years. Wade told me that he was not aware of any deer being shot on the farm that had an ear tag in the ear. On August 26, 2013 I was assigned this UIR. I spoke with Dr. Robert Carey DVM from the Ohio Department of Agriculture on August 26th. Dr. Carey wanted to inspect the Robert Schumaker facility on August 27th. I also coordinated with Wildlife Officer Supervisor Rick Rogers. Supervisor Rogers agreed to go along to assist with the inspection considering Mr. Schumaker recently had violent confrontation with a neighbor regarding deer. This confrontation resulted in the Clinton County Sheriff's Department responding to Mr. Schumaker's residence and filing a report. I also contacted District Five Law Enforcement Supervisor Michele Welsh to inform her of the planned inspection.

On August 27, 2013 at approximately 8:30am I met with Supervisor Rogers and Dr. Carey. We exchanged information and then proceeded to Mr. Schumaker's residence located at 6033 SR 350, Clarksville, Clinton County, Ohio. Mr. Schumaker was not home when we first arrived but he drove in a few minutes later (I activated my digital recorder). Supervisor Rogers informed him that we were there to inspect his captive deer. Mr. Schumaker advised Supervisor Rogers that he had killed all of the deer. We told Mr. Schumaker that we would like to inspect his records. He told us that they were in his house and he would go get them. Mr. Schmaker told us that 4 of his deer had escaped the enclosure after a tree fell on the fence some time around the end of October, 2012. Mr. Schumaker said that he contacted the District Office and notified them that some of his deer had escaped but he did not know who he spoke with. He told us that he shot the rest of the deer that were in the pen because they were getting too expensive to feed. He also said that another reason he shot them was because of the recent regulations that had come out regarding captive cervids. While Mr. Schumaker was in the house looking for his records, we walked down to the deer pen. There did not appear to be any deer in the enclosure as the grass was four feet or more tall. There were not any paths through the grass and there was no path around the inside perimeter of the fence. I took some photographs of the enclosure. A short time later Mr. Schumaker came out of the house with his record book. Mr. Schumaker's record book had recorded that on November 14, 2012 that he had butchered 10 deer. I questioned Mr. Schumaker if he had a filled the information out when he went in the house to retrieve the records. He immediately became agitated and told me to contact his attorney if I had any more questions. He calmed down and then continued answering and asking questions. I photographed Mr. Schumaker's propagator permits and his record book. Mr. Schumaker told us that he still sees some of the deer that escaped. Mr. Schumaker told us that of the deer that had escaped that one had a red ear tag, one had a green ear tag, one had a yellow ear tag and the last one did not have an ear tag. He told us that the most recent time he had seen one of the escaped deer was a week prior when he saw a deer with a yellow ear tag that had triplets with it. We explained to Mr. Schumaker our concerns with the spread of disease to the wild deer population. Mr. Schumaker agreed and told us that he would help by shooting the ear tagged deer if we wanted

I contacted Supervisor Welsh and explained to her the situation. I asked her if Mr. Schumaker was allowed to shoot the deer. Supervisor Welsh advised me that he could shoot the deer as long as he recognized the deer as being one of his with an ear tag. She also stated that if he did shoot one that he would need to notify us immediately so we could get it to the Ohio Department of Agriculture for CWD testing.

I relayed this information to Mr. Schumaker and told him that he needed to contact us immediately so we could get the deer head to ODA. He told us that he would cut the head off and put it on ice. Supervisor Rogers, Dr. Carey and I all gave Mr. Schumaker business cards with our cell phone numbers so he could contact one of us in the event that he shoots one of the deer. Dr. Carey also told Mr. Schumaker that he needed to cut the head off leaving as much of the neck attached so he could also test the lymph nodes for tuberulosis.



## NARRATIVE SUPPLEMENT INCIDENT NUMBER 13-14-017

VICTIM OFFENSE INCIDENT DATE 1531.02 AND TIME 8-22-1:

This narrative supplement is a follow up to UIR #13-14-017

On August 26, 2013 I was assigned this UIR. I spoke with Dr. Robert Carey DVM from the Ohio Department of Agriculture on August 26th. Dr. Carey wanted to inspect the Robert Schumaker facility on August 27th. I also coordinated with Wildlife Officer Supervisor Rick Rogers. Supervisor Rogers agreed to go along to assist with the inspection considering Mr. Schumaker recently had violent confrontation with a neighbor regarding deer. This confrontation resulted in the Clinton County Sheriff's Department responding to Mr. Schumaker's residence and filing a report. I also contacted District Five Law Enforcement Supervisor Michele Welsh to inform her of the planned inspection.

On August 27, 2013 at approximately 8:30am I met with Supervisor Rogers and Dr. Carey. We exchanged information and then proceeded to Mr. Schumaker's residence located at 6033 SR 350, Clarksville, Clinton County, Ohio. Mr. Schumaker was not home when we first arrived but he drove in a few minutes later (I activated my digital recorder). Supervisor Rogers informed him that we were there to inspect his captive deer. Mr. Schumaker advised Supervisor Rogers that he had killed all of the deer. We told Mr. Schumaker that we would like to inspect his records. He told us that they were in his house and he would go get them. Mr. Schmaker told us that 4 of his deer had escaped the enclosure after a tree fell on the fence some time around the end of October, 2012. Mr. Schumaker said that he contacted the District Office and notified them that some of his deer had escaped but he did not know who he spoke with. He told us that he shot the rest of the deer that were in the pen because they were getting too expensive to feed. He also said that another reason he shot them was because of the recent regulations that had come out regarding captive cervids. While Mr. Schumaker was in the house looking for his records, we walked down to the deer pen. There did not appear to be any deer in the enclosure as the grass was four feet or more tall. There were not any paths through the grass and there was no path around the inside perimeter of the fence. I took some photographs of the enclosure. A short time later Mr. Schumaker came out of the house with his record book. Mr. Schumaker's record book had recorded that on November 14, 2012 that he had butchered 10 deer. I questioned Mr. Schumaker if he had a filled the information out when he went in the house to retrieve the records. He immediately became agitated and told me to contact his attorney if I had any more questions. He calmed down and then continued answering and asking questions. I photographed Mr. Schumaker's propagator permits and his record book. Mr. Schumaker told us that he still sees some of the deer that escaped. Mr. Schumaker told us that of the deer that had escaped that one had a red ear tag, one had a green ear tag, one had a yellow ear tag and the last one did not have an ear tag. He told us that the most recent time he had seen one of the escaped deer was a week prior when he saw a deer with a yellow ear tag that had triplets with it. We explained to Mr. Schumaker our concerns with the spread of disease to the wild deer population. Mr. Schumaker agreed and told us that he would help by shooting the ear tagged deer if we wanted

I contacted Supervisor Welsh and explained to her the situation. I asked her if Mr. Schumaker was allowed to shoot the deer. Supervisor Welsh advised me that he could shoot the deer as long as he recognized the deer as being one of his with an ear tag. She also stated that if he did shoot one that he would need to notify us immediately so we could get it to the Ohio Department of Agriculture for CWD testing.

I relayed this information to Mr. Schumaker and told him that he needed to contact us immediately so we could get the deer head to ODA. He told us that he would cut the head off and put it on ice. Supervisor Rogers, Dr. Carey and I all gave Mr. Schumaker business cards with our cell phone numbers so he could contact one of us in the event that he shoots one of the deer. Dr. Carey also told Mr. Schumaker that he needed to cut the head off leaving as much of the neck attached so he could also test the lymph nodes for tuberulosis.

I asked the District Law Enforcement office if I should collect the tag as evidence and was told not to. On 1 December, 2013, I was asked to contact Robert Baughman (DOB 09-18-1969) regarding the release of Captive Breed Deer by his neighbor Robert P. Shumaker (DOB 03-05-1946). Baughman provided me with a list of people in the Clarksville community to contact regarding the events. Shannon Kearns (Clarksville Post Office) works at Post Officer John Sewell 937-289-2434 One of Shumakers breeder bucks was shot on Sewell's property. Shumaker got mad. This narrative supplement is a follow up to an Ohio Uniform Incident Report written by Officer Matt Hunt:

On January 13, 2014 at 10:00am I met with Clinton County Municipal Court Prosecutor Laura Railings in regards to the information detailed below. I briefed her on the interviews that I conducted and she declined to approve charges against Robert Shumaker stating that there was a lack of evidence of a crime being committed. CASE CLOSED.

I was assigned this investigation by Law Enforcement Supervisor Michele Welsh on 12/16/13.

I was asked to contact the individuals below regarding the release of propagated deer by Robert Shumaker (DOB 03-05-1946).

December 17, 2013 at 4:58pm I spoke with Steve Fisher. Mr. Fisher told me that he was at the Marathon Gas Station in Clarksville sometime during early summer 2013 and saw Robert Shumaker there. He spoke with Robert and they talked about various topics. Steve said that he asked Robert if he still had his deer and Robert replied that the gate was left open and the deer got out. Steve told me that Robert implied that the gate was left open intentionally but was not directly told by Robert that he left the gate open. I asked him how he implied it and he said it was just the way he said it. Steve said that Robert told him that the deer were tearing up his wife's flowers. I asked Steve if he would be willing to testify in court that Robert Shumaker intentionally released the deer and he said "no, because he didn't know for sure".

December 17, 2013 at 5:06pm I left a voicemail with John Sewell asking him to call me.

December 17, 2013 at 5:07pm I spoke with Tony Anderson and told him what I was investigating. Tony told me that his brother was the one that took the pictures of the deer with the ear tag in the ear. Tony told me that his brother did not have the pictures on his phone anymore. I asked him if he knew where the deer came from and he told me he thought Robert Shumaker. I asked him how he knew that and he told me that he heard from others in the neighborhood that it could be from Robert. I asked if he had any first hand knowledge that the deer was actually from Robert Shumaker's and he told me no.

December 17, 2013 at 5:22pm John Sewell called me back. I explained to John that I was investigating the release of propagated deer into the wild by one of his neighbors. John was not aware of what I was talking about and told me that he did not know of any tagged deer being shot on his property.

December 18, 2013 at 9:53am I spoke with Kevin Reynolds. Kevin told me that he was friends with Clint Shumaker. Clint is the son of Robert Shumaker. Kevin told me that he was at the Toby Keith bar in Cincinnati with Clint and Kevin asked about the deer that his dad had. Clint told Kevin that his dad had let the deer loose because they were getting too costly to take care of and have tested. Kevin said that he didn't think anything of it that it was just a conversation they had until he talked to Bobby Baughman. Kevin told me that Clint had a friend with him but Kevin couldn't remember the friend's name. This conversation took place sometime in early summer 2013. Kevin told me that he really would not want to testify against Clint since he is a friend.

December 18, 2013 at 11:27am I spoke with Shannon Kearns/Shumaker and explained to them that I was conducting an investigation regarding propagated deer being released into the wild and was told that they may have information that would assist in the case. They both said that they did not have any idea what I was talking about. They told me they did not know of any deer being released into the wild and did not know anyone that had propagated deer. Shannon explained that they see alot of deer on their mail routes but not any propagated deer.

December 18, 2013 at 3:19pm I spoke Wade Crady. He said that his father-in-law John Sewell called him and told him that I had called him. Wade told me that he is the caretaker of the property and has been for about 15 years. Wade told me that he was not aware of any deer being shot on the farm that had an ear tag in the ear. He told me that his daughter was the only one that shot a deer this year on the farm and it did not have an ear tag in it.
