School Culture Reminders

• **Cell Phones:** Students should not have cell phones out while at school or school events (this includes on transportation to fieldwork). This also includes during recess and before and afterschool. If students need to call home, they can use the phones in the main office.

Grading

• **Middle school:** Please continue to check Jumprope with your child. If you have questions or concerns, please contact your child's crew leader.

Attendance:

- It is critical that your child come to school every day, both to support their learning and to support their continued sense of belonging in our community.
- If you need to take your child out of school, please follow the procedures below:
 - If your child is sick or has a doctor's appointment, please call the main office to excuse their absence. If they are sick for more than 2 days, you will need a doctor's note to excuse their absence.
 - If you have a family emergency that is less than 5 days, please call the main office to let Sheila, Maria, or Adriana know.
 - If you have a family emergency that is 5 days or more, your child will need to complete an independent study packet so that they can continue learning while they are out of school. To request a packet and contract, please contact Adriana in the front office at least 72 hours in advance of your child's scheduled absence. She will ask you to sign a contract and will request a work packet from your child's teachers. If the absence is unplanned and you anticipate it will last for more than 5 days, please contact Adriana and share the circumstances with her. If she is able to create a contract and packet for you, she will, but we can not guarantee that contracts and packets requested last-minute will be honored.

• Please submit your child's work to your child's teacher upon their day of return.

New Recess Schedule

- Note: beginning Monday, October 22, the following grades will have altered recess schedules to support with behavior during recess, to provide a safe and predictable transition back to class with their teachers, and to give students optional additional time to eat their lunch outside:
 - 2nd Grade and 3rd Grade: Instead of recess then lunch, students will go to lunch, then recess. Should they choose to take their lunch outside with them to get extra eating time, they may do so. This block of time will still run from 11:25-11:55, with class resuming at 12. Their teachers will meet them on the yard to pick them up.
 - **Middle School:** Instead of recess then lunch, students will go to lunch, then recess. Should they choose to take their lunch outside with them to get extra eating time, they may do so. This block of time will still run from 11:08-11:38, with class resuming at 11:40. They will continue to walk themselves to class.
