- Can/should students attend?
 - **TK-2nd Grade:** Yes, students are welcome to attend their October conference but their attendance is not required at this conference.
 - o **3rd through 8th Grade:** Yes, students are required to attend their October conference, as they are leading the conference by sharing their work and their goals.

Blueprint School Design Team

- Last Thursday, I (Bri) met with the principals of SOL, Frick, Kaiser, and Sankofa to learn more about our next steps in the Blueprint process. While there are still many details to be worked out, I learned the following:
 - **THE WORK:** The core work of the Design Team will be focused both on equity and on ensuring MLA is ready to sustainably open our doors to more students and families next school year.



- **TEAM COMPOSITION**: We will form a design team that is composed of staff, teachers, families, dual language experts, and at times, students.
- THE COMMITMENT: The design team will meet every other Tuesday after school from 3:30-5:30pm. Additional committee work will also take place later in the year, but that will be opt-in. We will share more information about committees once the Design Team has been selected.
- ELECTION PROCESS:
 - MLA families will democratically elect 4 family representatives to the Design Team --
 - 1 TK-2 family member
 - 1 3-5 family member
 - 1 6-8 family member
 - 1 additional family member that represents a special population at MLA, such as our newcomers or our students with special needs
- **TIMELINE**: We hope to have the Design Team selected by mid to late-October, so, soon! During conferences next week, families will receive more information about how to nominate representatives and how to participate in the election process.
