PARKING LOT REPAVING

Sealed bids are hereby solicited for re-paving of the terminal parking lot at the New River Valley Airport. Improvements include surface preparation and asphalt overlay for an estimated 3,600 SY parking lot, including full area milling and restriping of 61 parking spaces.

This is a unit price Contract. Bids will be received in the office of the Airport Manager, 5391 C V Jackson Rd, Dublin, VA 24084 until 2:00 p.m., prevailing local time, Monday, August 17, 2020. Bids received after that time will not be accepted. Bids will be open publicly and read aloud immediately following receipt of the bids.

An optional Pre-Bid Conference will be held on Wednesday, August 5, 2020 at 3:30 p.m. in the Airport Conference Room via Zoom meeting. The virtual invitation will be distributed to all parties that inquire regarding bid documents (see below).

Bidding documents will be available for review at the airport terminal building, 5391 C V Jackson Rd, Dublin, VA 24084.

All questions concerning the project shall be submitted in writing to Jamie Peck, Eden & Associates, by emailing jamie@edenandassociates.com and to be given consideration must be received at least seven (7) business days prior to the date fixed for the opening of the bids. Eden & Associates is the only point through which information will be disseminated.

Bid security must accompany each proposal in accordance with the Information for Bidders. No bid may be withdrawn for a period of ninety (90) days after the opening thereof. The procedure specified under Code of Virginia Section 2.2-4330(B)(1) shall apply: “The bidder shall give notice in writing of his claim of right to withdraw his bid within two business days after the conclusion of the bid opening procedure...”.

The New River Valley Airport Commission reserves the right to reject any and all bids, waive informalities and irregularities in bidding and to accept bids which are considered to be in the best interest of the Airport.
