Sealed bids are hereby solicited for construction of the Hangar Site at the New River Valley Airport. Improvements include erosion & sediment control, grading, paving, and constructing water sewer, stormwater systems to a corporate hangar building pad, as well as site stabilization and other ancillary work associated with the Hangar Site improvements.

This is a unit price Contract. Bids will be received in the office of the Airport Manager, 5391 C V Jackson Rd, Dublin, VA 24084 until 4:00 p.m., prevailing local time, Thursday January 12, 2023. Bids received after that time will not be accepted. Bids will be open publicly and read aloud at 4:01 p.m.

An optional Pre-Bid Conference will be held on Friday December 16 at 2:30 p.m. in the Airport Conference Room at the address above.

Bid security must accompany each proposal in accordance with the Information for Bidders. No bid may be withdrawn for a period of ninety (90) days after the opening thereof. The procedure specified under Code of Virginia Section 2.2-4330(B)(1) shall apply: “The bidder shall give notice in writing of his claim of right to withdraw his bid within two business days after the conclusion of the bid opening procedure...”.

The New River Valley Airport Commission reserves the right to reject any and all bids, waive informalities and irregularities in bidding and to accept bids which are considered to be in the best interest of the Airport.
