Dear Fellow Good Sam Members,

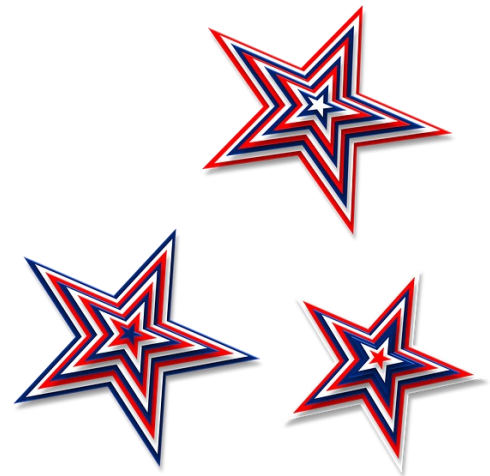

Toys for Foster Youth of Calaveras County donation

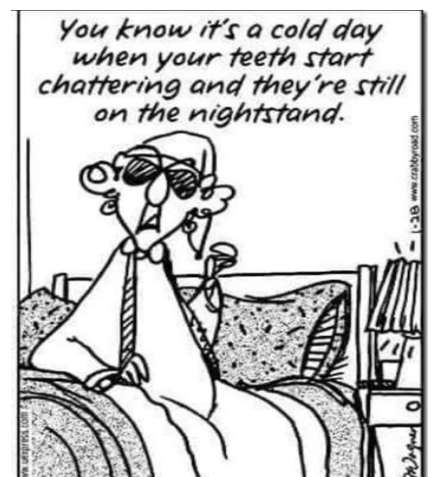
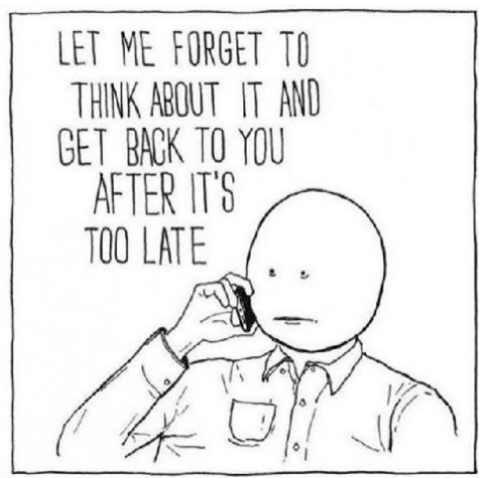
