

## The Great White Throne Judgment Revelation 20:11-16 Part 2

Introduction: In our text this morning John gives us some more details about "The Great White Throne Judgment." We learned last week that this judgment is reserved only for those who have never believed on Christ. There will not be one saved person at this judgment. We also learned that the purpose for this judgment is to determine what sentence or degree of punishment each person will receive which leads us to question, how does God judge each person? Apart from the obvious that God has all knowledge and is perfect in His judgments, John tells us there are several books which gives evidence of crimes committed against God. What are these books that John is referring to? I want to also look at a strange phrase that John uses called the second death. What is the second death, how do you explain two deaths?
