



THE PLAN

After careful consideration, the Pool Committee has decided to move forward with Version #9. This decision was made after receiving favorable feedback from the Evanston City Council, all municipalities in Uinta County, and the County Commissioners.

Version #9 is pictured below and includes the following features:

- New indoor aquatic facility with separate competition pool and recreation pool
- 8 lane, 25-meter competition pool
- Observation deck overseeing competition pool
- Zero depth entry (ZDE) recreation pool
- Toddler slide & geysers in ZDE
- Water slide
- Lazy river
- Water walk
- Spa/hot tub
- Concessions
- 3 party rooms

The recreation center's current indoor pool will be converted into a Gymnastics Center opening up additional gym space in the rec center's gymnasium.
