

Welcome! This section is for the enrollment of our Reader's Theater for students in grades 3rd through 8th.

Readers Theater is a highly motivational reading strategy that provides a context for authentic reading. This is an exciting way to challenge kids to a collaborative literacy activity that incorporates reading, writing, speaking, and listening.



Together, students read scripts aloud multiple times to improve reading accuracy, rate, and expression.

Students will learn to better read to convey meaning using their voice, facial expressions, and gestures.

Students will learn how to analyze and respond to literature and increase reading fluency.

Reader's theater is also about having fun while reading. The light structure encourages students to creatively engage in the activity without the stress of performance perfection. Reader's theater also provides opportunities for success and increases students' motivation and oral presentation skills.

During the last week of each summer session, students will perform the script to an audience which will be the students, staff, and friends and families of our summer program students.
