# FIREARM INVENTORY AT TRANSFER

This Firearm Inventory at Transfer is completed to the best of the knowledge and ability of the transferring and receiving parties at the time of physical transfer. Firearms may vary widely in age, configuration, finish, and originality, and some firearms may possess unique characteristics not fully captured through standardized fields.

The information recorded herein reflects a good-faith visual and functional assessment based on observable condition at the time of transfer. This inventory is intended solely to document identification and general condition for chain-of-custody and compliance purposes and does not represent an appraisal, valuation, authentication, or guarantee of function.

Reasonable efforts will be made to accurately describe each firearm. Minor variances or undiscovered conditions may be identified during subsequent licensed inspection or processing.



## CONDITION CATEGORIES

### Condition A — Excellent

- Appears nearly new or lightly used
- Minimal to no visible wear
- Original finish largely intact
- No visible corrosion or mechanical issues

### Condition B — Good

- Normal wear consistent with use
- Minor finish wear or handling marks
- Mechanically intact with no obvious defects
- No structural damage observed

### Condition C — Fair

- Noticeable wear, finish loss, or cosmetic damage
- Possible surface corrosion or pitting
- Mechanical condition unknown or untested
- Firearm remains intact and identifiable

### Condition D — Poor

- Significant wear, corrosion, or damage
- Missing or damaged components
- Not functional or function unknown
- May require repair or parts replacement

### Condition E — Non-Serviceable

- Unsafe to fire or incomplete
- Severely damaged or altered
- Designated for parts, training, or destruction
- Not suitable for resale

### Disposition & Condition Acknowledgment

Guns 4 Good accepts firearms of all conditions, including those that are incomplete, non-functional, damaged, or otherwise unsuitable for resale. Acceptance of a firearm does not constitute a guarantee that the firearm will be offered for direct resale.

Following lawful transfer to a licensed Federal Firearms Licensee ("FFL") and/or Guns 4 Good processing partner, each firearm is subject to further inspection and evaluation. Based on safety, legality, and suitability, a firearm may be:

- Prepared for lawful resale
- Designated for parts or training use
- Removed from circulation and responsibly destroyed in accordance with applicable law

Guns 4 Good makes **best-faith efforts** to monetize every donated firearm in support of its charitable mission. However, in some instances, safety, legal, or practical considerations may require alternative disposition. Such determinations are made solely by licensed partners and do not affect the charitable nature of the donation.
