Mr. Ridout,

Timmons Group has completed a preliminary desktop evaluation for the Hunting Hawk Technology Park (Site) utilizing the Virginia Department of Historic Resources (DHR) Virginia Cultural Resource Information System (VCRIS). The purpose of this desktop evaluation and database query is to provide a preliminary compilation of documented historic and/or cultural resources within the proposed project area and within a 0.25-mile radius surrounding the Site.

Based upon the results of the evaluation, no known architectural or archaeological resources have been documented within the proposed project limits. The results of the VCRIS search identified three (3) architectural resources located offsite within a 0.25-mile radius surrounding the project limits. Maps depicting the locations of these resources are included in <a href="Attachment 1: DHR VCRIS Cultural Resource Search Maps">Attachment 1: DHR VCRIS Cultural Resource Maps</a>. Detailed DHR VCRIS reports for each resource have been filed in alphanumeric order and are enclosed as Attachment 2: DHR Architectural Resource VCRIS Reports.

## **Architectural Resources**

Three (3) known architectural resources (DHR IDs: 042-5649, 042-5650, 042-5651) were identified offsite within the 0.25-mile radius surrounding the project area. All three offsite resources have been deemed "Not Eligible" for register listing by DHR staff. These three resources all consist of single-family dwellings.

#### **Summary and Conclusions**

If work is proposed in wetlands or Waters of the U.S., then Section 401 and Section 404 Clean Water Act Permits will be required. Submittal of a Section 404 Clean Water Act Permit will provide a federal nexus that will trigger review of cultural resources through Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act, which could impose timeline restrictions or reduce the developable footprint of the project area.

A Phase I Cultural Resource investigation of the Site may be recommended by DHR and required by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers as part of any federal/state permitting process as previously



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identified resources have been identified near project area. Initiating a Phase I investigation early in the design process may help prevent delays and/or reduce efforts associated with late discoveries of previously unidentified cultural resources within the Site.
