Current Rule Name: 6.1 General

Updated Rule: Outlaw Karts Australia Inc. recognized Classes

250cc Intermediate Outlaw Karts

- 11* – 16 years of age. (*Transition at 10 years must have approval from the State Member Club Committee.) Day of 17th birthday must advance to 450cc Open class.

NSWOK Criteria: State Member Club Committee to develop criteria for drivers under 12 years old, considering elements such as, but not limited to:

- 1) Drivers under 12 years of age must have prior motorsports experience;
- 2) Drivers under 12 must start ROF for 3 meetings or until deemed competent by steward;
- 3) Driving control;
- 4) Ability to follow race instructions;
- 5) Physical ability of individual.
- 6) Final decision for drivers under 12 years of age to be made by State Member Club Executive Committee.
