The Solemnity of Corpus Christi, The Body and Blood of Christ

This weekend, the Church throughout the world celebrates the Eucharist, the Body and Blood of Christ. We believe in the real presence of Jesus - body, soul, and divinity - in the Blessed Sacrament. In every Church where the Blessed Sacrament is reserved there is a candle burning. The candle says: Yes, Our Lord Jesus is with us; Yes, God is present here. In every corner of the world: from the great Basilica of St. Peter's in Rome to the smallest village in a remote part of the world, a candle burns near the tabernacle that says to you that God is present, do not be afraid. The Eucharist is the gift our Lord Jesus gave to us the night before he died when Jesus said: "This is my body, this is my Blood, do this in memory of me."

On Sunday the Parishes in the City of Camden will once again come together for a Eucharistic Procession through the city. The procession will begin at 1:00 p.m. at Sacred Heart Church and proceed down Broadway to the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception. From the Cathedral, the procession will continue up Federal Street to St. Joseph's Pro-Cathedral, arriving at approximately 3:00 p.m., for final prayers and benediction. Camden Metro Police will escort those in procession. The total walk is approximately 3.5 miles. For those who do not want to walk you may join us in your vehicle and drive behind those walking. Cars are asked to line up on Ferry Avenue in Camden near Sacred Heart Church by 12:45 p.m., facing Broadway. A bus will transport walkers back to Sacred Heart Church at the end of the procession. All are invited to join us as we spread our faith in the city. O Sacrament most holy, O Sacrament Divine, all praise and all thanksgiving be every moment thine. God Bless you and your family,

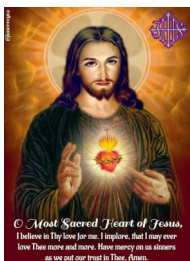

Here are some examples of Acts of Mercy and Adoration:

Acts of Mercy for Adults

- Prepare a meal for a sick or elderly neighbor. * Visit, call or write to someone in a nursing home or hospital. * Donate food, clothing, or hygiene items to the parish. * Volunteer at a parish outreach ministry or food pantry. * Offer transportation to Mass or medical appointments. * Write encouraging note to a home-bound parishioner. * Pray for someone who has hurt you.
- * Reach out and invite a person back to church who has drifted away. * Offer to pray with someone in need. * Forgive an old resentment. * Volunteer in our school of faith formation program. * Pray the Rosary for the parish. * Offer fasting or sacrifices for the healing of the nation. * Pray for the undocumented in our community and for a change in immigration law and policy.

Acts of Adoration for Adults

- * Spend one hour before the Blessed Sacrament. * Attend daily Mass. * Make a Holy Hour in reparation for sins against the Sacred Heart. * Pray the Litany of the Sacred Heart. * Enthroned an image of the Sacred Heart in the home. * Attend Mass on a First Friday or First Saturday. * Pray silently for the nation before the tabernacle. * Offer sacrifices united to the Heart of Jesus. * Pray the Rosary for the Church and our country. Turn off your phone, television or computer and spend time in prayer.

Acts of Mercy for Children

- Share toys or school supplies with someone in need
- Help parents or grandparents without complaining
- Pray for someone who is sick
- Make cards for the elderly or homebound
- Include someone who is left out at school
- Say kind words instead of teasing or arguing
- Put coins in charity jar for the poor
- Offer chores or sacrifices "for the Sacred Heart of Jesus"

Acts of Adoration for Children

- * Visit Jesus in Church. * Draw pictures and write prayers to the Sacred Heart. * Learn and pray this short prayer: "Jesus, meek and humble of heart, make mine like Yours." * Light a candle and pray for our country. * Turn off your phone, television or computer and spend time talking to Jesus.

Pray an Our Father, 10 Hail Marys, and a Glory be for our Church and our country.

La Solemnidad del Corpus Christi: El Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo

Este fin de semana, la Iglesia en todo el mundo celebra la Eucaristía: el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo. Creemos en la presencia real de Jesús —cuerpo, alma y divinidad— en el Santísimo Sacramento. En cada iglesia donde se reserva el Santísimo Sacramento, arde una vela. Esa vela proclama: «Sí, Nuestro Señor Jesús está con nosotros; sí, Dios está presente aquí». En cada rincón del mundo —desde la gran Basílica de San Pedro en Roma hasta la aldea más pequeña en una región remota del planeta— arde una vela cerca del sagrario, diciéndote que Dios está presente y que no debes temer. La Eucaristía es el don que Nuestro Señor Jesús nos entregó la noche antes de morir, cuando dijo: «Esto es mi Cuerpo, esta es mi Sangre; hagan esto en memoria mía».

El domingo, las parroquias de la ciudad de Camden se unirán una vez más para realizar una Procesión Eucarística a través de la ciudad. La procesión comenzará a la 1:00 p. m. en la Iglesia del Sagrado Corazón y avanzará por Broadway hasta llegar a la Catedral de la Inmaculada Concepción. Desde la Catedral, la procesión continuará por Federal Street hasta la Pro-Catedral de San José, llegando aproximadamente a las 3:00 p. m. para las oraciones finales y la bendición. La Policía Metropolitana de Camden escoltará a los participantes de la procesión. El recorrido total a pie es de aproximadamente 3.5 millas. Aquellos que no deseen caminar pueden unirse a nosotros en sus vehículos, conduciendo detrás del grupo de caminantes. Se solicita a los automóviles que se formen en Ferry Avenue, en Camden en la Iglesia del Sagrado Corazón— antes de las 12:45 p. m., orientados hacia Broadway. Un autobús transportará a los caminantes de regreso a la Iglesia del Sagrado Corazón al finalizar la procesión. Todos están invitados a unirse a nosotros mientras difundimos nuestra fe por la ciudad. ¡Oh, Santísimo Sacramento! ¡Oh, Sacramento Divino! Toda alabanza y toda acción de gracias sean tuyas en cada momento. Que Dios los bendiga a ustedes y a sus familias.
