Pastor's Corner

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Sunday of the Word of God

Several years ago, Pope Francis declared this Third Sunday of Ordinary Time as “*Sunday of the Word of God.*” This is a day to reflect upon the importance of Scripture in our daily life. The Vatican noted that the Sunday of the Word of God was initiated to reawaken an awareness of the importance of Sacred Scripture for our lives as believers, beginning with its presence in the liturgy at Sunday and daily Mass. Recently, Pope Leo XIV stated that God’s Word in Sacred Scripture provides “*nourishment in weariness, hope in darkness, and strength in our communities.*” He prayed that all Christians may draw strength and guidance from the Word of God and that the Church may always proclaim the Gospel with joy. I pray we all may grow in knowledge and love of God’s Word.

This year on most Sundays, we will proclaim from the Gospel of St. Matthew. I encourage you to open your Bibles and read the Gospel of Matthew. Matthew’s Gospel is often referred to as the ‘*the Gospel of Christ, the Teacher.*’ It is the Gospel of the Beatitudes and the Sermon on the Mount (Mt. 5-7,) the Last Judgement (Mt. 25) and the great commission for us to “*Go therefore and make disciples of all nations.*” (Mt. 28) In this Gospel, (Matt 4:12–23,) Jesus begins His public ministry and proclaims that the Kingdom of God is at hand, and calls ordinary fishermen to follow Him.

As we read this passage prayerfully during the week, we are invited to hear Christ’s call in our own lives—to turn toward Him, to trust Him, and to become disciples who share His light with others. Coming to Mass having reflected on the Word helps us recognize that the same Jesus who called the first disciples continues to call us today. I pray the Word of God continues to enlighten and inspire you to encounter the love of Jesus and to share that love with others. Word of God, come into our minds and hearts. Amen.

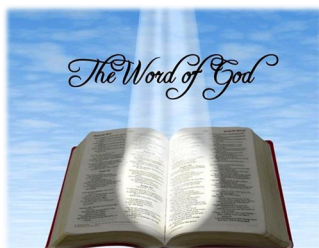

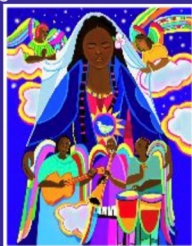

Rincón del Pastor

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Domingo de la Palabra de Dios

Hace varios años, el Papa Francisco declaró este Tercer Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario como el “*Domingo de la Palabra de Dios*”. Este es un día para reflexionar sobre la importancia de las Sagradas Escrituras en nuestra vida diaria. El Vaticano señaló que el “Domingo de la Palabra de Dios” se instituyó para reavivar la conciencia de la importancia de las Sagradas Escrituras para nuestras vidas como creyentes, comenzando por su presencia en la liturgia de la Misa dominical y diaria. El Papa Francisco afirmó que la Palabra de Dios en las Sagradas Escrituras proporciona “*alimento en el cansancio, esperanza en la oscuridad y fortaleza en nuestras comunidades*”. Oró para que todos los Cristianos obtengan fuerza y guía de la Palabra de Dios y para que la Iglesia siempre proclame el Evangelio con alegría. Oro para que todos crezcamos en el conocimiento y el amor de la Palabra de Dios.

Este año, en la mayoría de los Domingos, proclamaremos el Evangelio de San Mateo. Los animo a abrir sus Biblias y leer el Evangelio de Mateo. El Evangelio de Mateo a menudo se conoce como el “*Evangelio de Cristo, el Maestro*”. Es el Evangelio de las Bienaventuranzas y del Sermón de la Montaña (Mt 5-7), del Juicio Final (Mt 25) y del gran mandato de “Id, pues, y haced discípulos a todas las naciones” (Mt 28). En este Evangelio (Mt 4,12-23), Jesús comienza su ministerio público y proclama que el Reino de Dios está cerca, y llama a pescadores comunes a seguirlo.

Al leer este pasaje con oración durante la semana, estamos invitados a escuchar el llamado de Cristo en nuestras propias vidas: a volvernos hacia Él, a confiar en Él y a convertirnos en discípulos que comparten su luz con los demás. Llegar a Misa después de haber reflexionado sobre la Palabra nos ayuda a reconocer que el mismo Jesús que llamó a los primeros discípulos continúa llamándonos hoy. Oro para que la Palabra de Dios continúe iluminándonos e inspirándonos a encontrar el amor de Jesús y a compartir ese amor con los demás. Palabra de Dios, ven a nuestras mentes y corazones. Amén.
