Prayer: Trusting in Heavenly Treasure (Based on Luke 12:13–21)

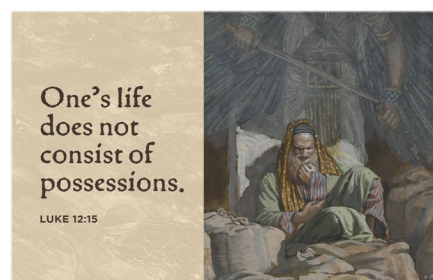

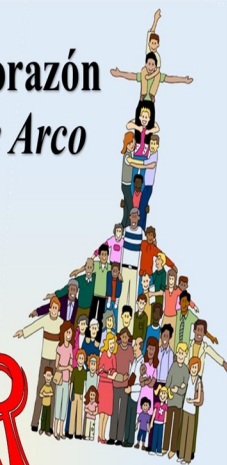
