A few weeks ago in my column I mentioned that Pope Francis declared 2025 to be a Jubilee Year. To prepare for the Holy Year next year, Pope Francis want this year of 2024 to be a “Year of Prayer.” in preparation for the Holy Year. I refer you to the Vatican’s document which can be found at www.iubilaeum2025.va.

In that document Pope Francis stressed the importance of family prayer. For example, grace before meals as a family is so important and sets an amazing example for children of the importance of prayer. Attending Mass and parish devotions as a family is also important. In the document the Pope provides for us a prayer for the morning and the evening. I suggest you cut these prayers out from the bulletin, and pray them with your spouse and children. If you live alone pray the prayers with the intentions of your family in mind.

Amen.”

Forgive me the wrong that I committed today and accept any good I have done. Guard me through the night and deliver me from danger. May your grace be always with me and all my loved ones. Amen.

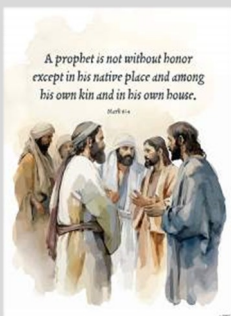

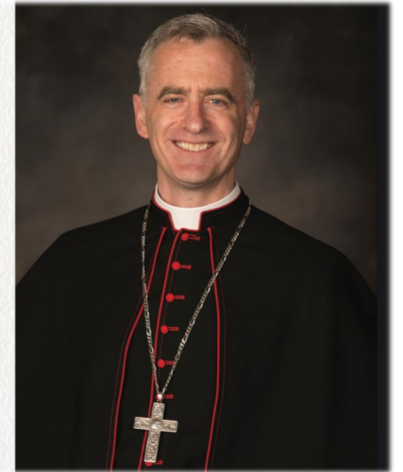
